

HOUSE BILL No. 5927

March 9, 2010, Introduced by Reps. Neumann, Spade, Gonzales, Polidori and Hammel and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 32, entitled
"Emergency 9-1-1 service enabling act,"
(MCL 484.1101 to 484.1717) by adding section 322.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 322. (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL REQUIRE ALL 9-1-1 CALL
2 CENTERS IN THIS STATE TO SUBMIT A CONSOLIDATION PLAN NO LATER THAN
3 24 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED
4 THIS SECTION.

5 (2) A CONSOLIDATION PLAN UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL COMPLY WITH
6 THE FOLLOWING:

7 (A) A CONSOLIDATED CALL CENTER SHALL BE DESIGNED TO SERVE
8 100,000 PEOPLE ACCORDING TO THE LATEST FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS.

9 (B) A CONSOLIDATED CALL CENTER SHALL CONTAIN EQUIPMENT THAT

1 ACCEPTS CALLS, TEXT MESSAGES, OR OTHER COMMUNICATIONS FROM ALL
2 WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES.

3 (3) NO LATER THAN 6 MONTHS AFTER RECEIVING A CONSOLIDATION
4 PLAN UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE COMMISSION SHALL REVIEW AND APPROVE
5 OR DISAPPROVE EACH CONSOLIDATION PLAN UNDER THIS SECTION. IF THE
6 COMMISSION DOES NOT ACT BY 6 MONTHS AFTER RECEIVING A CONSOLIDATION
7 PLAN UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE CONSOLIDATION PLAN IS CONSIDERED
8 APPROVED. IF THE CONSOLIDATION PLAN IS DISAPPROVED, THE COMMISSION
9 SHALL ADJUST THE PLAN TO ENSURE THAT THE PLAN COMPLIES WITH
10 SUBSECTION (2).
