A bill to amend 1986 PA 32, entitled "Emergency 9-1-1 service enabling act,"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 322. (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL REQUIRE ALL 9-1-1 CALL
- 2 CENTERS IN THIS STATE TO SUBMIT A CONSOLIDATION PLAN NO LATER THAN
- 3 24 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED
- 4 THIS SECTION.
- 5 (2) A CONSOLIDATION PLAN UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL COMPLY WITH
- 6 THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) A CONSOLIDATED CALL CENTER SHALL BE DESIGNED TO SERVE
 - 100,000 PEOPLE ACCORDING TO THE LATEST FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS.
 - (B) A CONSOLIDATED CALL CENTER SHALL CONTAIN EQUIPMENT THAT

- 1 ACCEPTS CALLS, TEXT MESSAGES, OR OTHER COMMUNICATIONS FROM ALL
- 2 WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES.
- 3 (3) NO LATER THAN 6 MONTHS AFTER RECEIVING A CONSOLIDATION
- 4 PLAN UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE COMMISSION SHALL REVIEW AND APPROVE
- 5 OR DISAPPROVE EACH CONSOLIDATION PLAN UNDER THIS SECTION. IF THE
- 6 COMMISSION DOES NOT ACT BY 6 MONTHS AFTER RECEIVING A CONSOLIDATION
