

# HOUSE BILL No. 6039

April 13, 2010, Introduced by Rep. Lemmons and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 312, entitled

"An act to provide for compulsory arbitration of labor disputes in municipal police and fire departments; to define such public departments; to provide for the selection of members of arbitration panels; to prescribe the procedures and authority thereof; and to provide for the enforcement and review of awards thereof,"

by amending section 13 (MCL 423.243).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 13. (1) During **MEDIATION OR** the pendency of proceedings  
2 before the arbitration panel, existing wages, hours, and other  
3 conditions of employment shall not be changed **FROM THE TERMS OF THE**  
4 **MOST RECENTLY APPLICABLE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT** by action  
5 of either party without the consent of the other, but a party may  
6 so consent without prejudice to his **OR HER** rights or position under

1 this act.

2 (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A PAYROLL DEDUCTION  
3 AUTHORIZED IN A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT IS A CONDITION OF  
4 EMPLOYMENT.
