June 1, 2010, Introduced by Reps. McMillin, Calley, Daley, Pavlov, Stamas, Moore, Rocca, Moss, Bolger, Tyler, Denby, Rick Jones, Walsh, Proos, Meadows, Lund, Knollenberg, Haines and Crawford and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 601b (MCL 257.601b), as amended by 2008 PA 296.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 601b. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
 act, a person responsible for a moving violation in a work zone, at
 an emergency scene, or in a school zone during the period beginning
 and minutes before school in the morning and through 30 minutes
 after school in the afternoon, OR IN A SCHOOL BUS ZONE is subject
 to a fine that is double the fine otherwise prescribed for that
 moving violation.
 - (2) A person who commits a moving violation in a work zone OR A SCHOOL BUS ZONE for which not fewer than 3 points are assigned under section 320a and as a result causes injury to another person in the work zone OR SCHOOL BUS ZONE is guilty of a misdemeanor

- 1 punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or imprisonment for
- 2 not more than 1 year, or both.
- 3 (3) A person who commits a moving violation in a work zone OR
- 4 SCHOOL BUS ZONE for which not fewer than 3 points are assigned

- 6 in the work zone OR SCHOOL BUS ZONE is guilty of a felony

- 22 SCHOOL BUS THAT HAS STOPPED AND IS DISPLAYING 2 ALTERNATELY
- 23 FLASHING RED LIGHTS AT THE SAME LEVEL, EXCEPT AS DESCRIBED IN
