## **HOUSE BILL No. 6403**

August 25, 2010, Introduced by Reps. Slavens, Tlaib, Roberts, Wayne Schmidt, Neumann and Liss and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Outdoor Recreation and Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

by amending section 12a (MCL 28.432a), as amended by 2006 PA 559.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 12a. (1) The requirements of this act for obtaining a
  - license to carry a concealed pistol do not apply to any of the
- following:
  - (a) A peace officer of a duly authorized police agency of the

- 2 state, who is regularly employed and paid by the United States or
- 3 this state or a subdivision of this state, except a township
- 4 constable.
- 5 (b) A constable who is trained and certified under the
- 6 commission on law enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL
- 7 28.601 to 28.616, while engaged in his or her official duties or
- 8 going to or coming from his or her official duties, and who is
- 9 regularly employed and paid by a political subdivision of this
- 10 state.
- 11 (c) A person regularly employed by the department of
- 12 corrections and authorized in writing by the director of the
- 13 department of corrections to carry a concealed pistol during the
- 14 performance of his or her duties or while going to or returning
- 15 from his or her duties.
- 16 (d) A person regularly employed as a local corrections officer
- 17 by a county sheriff, who is trained in the use of force and is
- 18 authorized in writing by the county sheriff to carry a concealed
- 19 pistol during the performance of his or her duties.
- 20 (e) A person regularly employed in a city jail or lockup who
- 21 has custody of persons detained or incarcerated in the jail or
- 22 lockup, is trained in the use of force, and is authorized in
- 23 writing by the chief of police or the county sheriff to carry a
- 24 concealed pistol during the performance of his or her duties.
- 25 (f) A member of the United States army, air force, navy, or
- 26 marine corps while carrying a concealed pistol in the line of duty.
- 27 (g) A member of the national guard, armed forces reserves, or

- 1 other duly authorized military organization while on duty or drill
- 2 or while going to or returning from his or her place of assembly or
- 3 practice or while carrying a concealed pistol for purposes of that
- 4 military organization.
- 5 (h) A resident of another state who is licensed by that state
- 6 to carry a concealed pistol.
- 7 (i) The regular and ordinary transportation of a pistol as
- 8 merchandise by an authorized agent of a person licensed to
- 9 manufacture firearms.
- 10 (j) A person while carrying a pistol unloaded in a wrapper or
- 11 container in the trunk of his or her vehicle or, if the vehicle
- 12 does not have a trunk, from transporting that pistol unloaded in a
- 13 locked compartment or container that is separated from the
- 14 ammunition for that pistol from the place of purchase to his or her
- 15 home or place of business or to a place of repair or back to his or
- 16 her home or place of business, or in moving goods from 1 place of
- 17 abode or business to another place of abode or business.
- 18 (k) A peace officer or law enforcement officer from Canada.
- 19 (l) A RAILROAD POLICE OFFICER APPOINTED UNDER SECTION 367 OF
- 20 THE RAILROAD CODE OF 1993, 1993 PA 354, MCL 462.367.
- 21 (2) As used in this act, "local corrections officer" means
- 22 that term as defined in section 2 of the local corrections officers
- 23 training act, 2003 PA 125, MCL 791.532.
