THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2836A. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SECTION 2836 IS GUILTY OF A
- 2 FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS OR A
- 3 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 5 unless House Bill No. 5929 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into
- 6 law.
