

# HOUSE BILL No. 6561

November 10, 2010, Introduced by Reps. Barnett and Miller and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1919 PA 339, entitled  
"Dog law of 1919,"  
(MCL 287.261 to 287.290) by adding section 10a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 10A. (1) A PERSON WHO OPERATES A LARGE-SCALE COMMERCIAL  
2 BREEDING KENNEL SHALL APPLY TO THE COUNTY TREASURER FOR A LARGE-  
3 SCALE COMMERCIAL BREEDING KENNEL LICENSE.

4           (2) THE COUNTY TREASURER MAY CHARGE A REASONABLE FEE FOR THE  
5 ISSUANCE OF A LARGE-SCALE COMMERCIAL BREEDING KENNEL LICENSE UNDER  
6 SUBSECTION (1).

7           (3) A PERSON WHO OBTAINS A LARGE-SCALE COMMERCIAL BREEDING  
8 KENNEL LICENSE UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL OF THE  
9 PROVISIONS CONCERNING LARGE-SCALE COMMERCIAL BREEDING KENNELS AS  
10 PROVIDED IN THE PUPPY PROTECTION ACT.

1           (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "LARGE-SCALE COMMERCIAL BREEDING  
2 KENNEL" MEANS A KENNEL WHERE MORE THAN 10 LITTERS OF PUPPIES ARE  
3 PRODUCED FOR SALE AS PETS IN A CALENDAR YEAR.

4           Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January  
5 1, 2012.

6           Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
7 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 6562(request no.  
8 07552'10) of the 95th Legislature is enacted into law.
