## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 7457. Sections 7451 to 7455 do not apply to any of the following:
- (a) An object sold or offered for sale to a person licensedunder article 15 or under the occupational code, 1980 PA 299, MCL
- **5** 339.101 to <del>339.2721</del> **339.2919**, or any intern, trainee, apprentice,
  - or assistant in a profession licensed under article 15 or under the
  - occupational code, 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.101 to 339.2721 339.2919,
- 8 for use in that profession.

- 10 SERVICE, AN APPROVED SERVICE PROGRAM, OR AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL
- 11 SERVICE AUTHORIZED, PROVIDED, OR ASSISTED UNDER ARTICLE 6 AND WHO
- 12 IS ACTING IN THE NORMAL LEGAL COURSE OF PROVIDING THOSE SERVICES.
