A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956,"

(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3406s.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 3406S. (1) AN EXPENSE-INCURRED HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR
- 2 SURGICAL POLICY OR CERTIFICATE DELIVERED, ISSUED FOR DELIVERY, OR
- 3 RENEWED IN THIS STATE AND A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION
- 4 CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR THE SCREENING, DIAGNOSIS, AND
- 5 TREATMENT OF AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED
- 6 TO, COVERAGE FOR SPEECH THERAPY, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY, PHYSICAL
- 7 THERAPY, PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES, PSYCHIATRIC SERVICES, AND APPLIED
- 8 BEHAVIORAL ANALYSIS, AS PRESCRIBED OR ORDERED BY THE INSURED'S OR
- 9 ENROLLEE'S TREATING PHYSICIAN OR PSYCHOLOGIST.

- 25 (B) "AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER" MEANS ANY OF THE PERVASIVE
- 26 DEVELOPMENTAL DISORDERS AS DEFINED BY THE MOST RECENT EDITION OF
- 27 THE DIAGNOSTIC AND STATISTICAL MANUAL OF MENTAL DISORDERS (DSM),
