## **SENATE BILL No. 431**

April 2, 2009, Introduced by Senator KUIPERS and referred to the Committee on Government Operations and Reform.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 306, entitled "Administrative procedures act of 1969," by amending section 39 (MCL 24.239), as amended by 2004 PA 23.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 39. (1) Before initiating any changes or additions to

rules, an agency shall electronically file with the office of
regulatory reform STATE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS AND RULES
a request for rule-making in a format prescribed by the office of
regulatory reform STATE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS AND
RULES. The request for rule-making shall include the following:

(a) The state or federal statutory or regulatory basis for the
rule. If THERE IS A FEDERAL STATUTORY OR REGULATORY STANDARD IN
EXISTENCE THAT IS SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR, THE AGENCY SHALL CITE AND

DESCRIBE THAT STATUTORY OR REGULATORY STANDARD.

- 1 (b) The problem the rule intends to address.
- 2 (c) An assessment of the significance of the problem.
- 3 (D) A COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS REGARDING ANY NEW RULES OR CHANGES
- 4 TO EXISTING RULES.
- 5 (2) IF AN AGENCY CITES AND DESCRIBES A SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR
- 6 FEDERAL STATUTORY OR REGULATORY STANDARD AND IF THE REQUEST FOR
- 7 RULE-MAKING SEEKS STANDARDS THAT ARE MORE STRINGENT THAN THAT
- 8 FEDERAL STATUTORY OR REGULATORY STANDARD, THE STATE OFFICE OF
- 9 ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS AND RULES SHALL DENY THE REQUEST FOR RULE-
- 10 MAKING.
- 11 (3) (2)—An agency shall not proceed with the processing of a
- 12 rule outlined in this chapter unless the office of regulatory
- 13 reform STATE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS AND RULES has
- 14 approved the request for rule-making.
- 15 (4) (3)—The office of regulatory reform—STATE OFFICE OF
- 16 ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS AND RULES shall record the receipt of all
- 17 requests for rule-making on the internet and shall make electronic
- 18 or paper copies of approved requests for rule-making available to
- 19 members of the general public upon request.
- 20 (5) (4)—The office of regulatory reform STATE OFFICE OF
- 21 ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS AND RULES shall immediately make available
- 22 to the committee electronic copies of the request for rule-making
- 23 submitted to the office of regulatory reform STATE OFFICE OF
- 24 ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS AND RULES. On a weekly basis, the office of
- 25 regulatory reform-STATE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS AND RULES
- 26 shall electronically provide to the committee a listing of all
- 27 requests for rule-making approved or denied during the previous

- 1 week. The committee shall electronically provide a copy of the
- 2 approved and denied requests for rule-making, not later than the
- 3 next business day after receipt of the notice from the office of
- 4 regulatory reform STATE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS AND
- 5 RULES, to members of the committee and to members of the standing
- 6 committees of the senate and house of representatives that deal
- 7 with the subject matter of the proposed rule.
- 8 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR" MEANS
- 9 IDENTICAL, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF STYLE OR FORMAT DIFFERENCES NEEDED
- 10 TO CONFORM TO THIS OR OTHER STATE LAWS.
