THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 521A. (1) IF A PERSON OR GROUP IS NOT COMPLYING WITH THE
- 2 VOTER REGISTRATION PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR
- 3 ANY PERSON MAY COMMENCE A CIVIL ACTION FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF TO
- 4 COMPEL COMPLIANCE OR TO ENJOIN FURTHER NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE VOTER
 - REGISTRATION PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT.
 - (2) AN ACTION FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE
- 7 BROUGHT IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE DEFENDANT
- 8 IS LOCATED, RESIDES, OR IS DOING BUSINESS. THE COURT HAS
- 9 JURISDICTION TO ENJOIN NONCOMPLIANCE AND TO REQUIRE COMPLIANCE WITH
