

SENATE BILL No. 1027

December 10, 2009, Introduced by Senators GLEASON, HUNTER, CLARKE, SCOTT, CLARK-COLEMAN, THOMAS, JACOBS, BRATER, PRUSI, CHERRY, OLSHOVE, SWITALSKI and ANDERSON and referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled
"The insurance code of 1956,"
(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 203.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 203. A PERSON WHO HOLDS THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER SHALL
2 NOT MAKE EXPENDITURES FOR, RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR LOBBYING FROM,
3 OR BE EMPLOYED BY ANY OF THE FOLLOWING FOR 2 YEARS AFTER LEAVING
4 THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER:

5 (A) AN INSURER OR OTHER ENTITY REGULATED UNDER THIS ACT.

6 (B) A NONPROFIT HEALTH CARE CORPORATION REGULATED UNDER THE
7 NONPROFIT HEALTH CARE CORPORATION REFORM ACT, 1980 PA 350, MCL
8 550.1101 TO 550.1704.

9 (C) A THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRATOR REGULATED UNDER THE THIRD

1 PARTY ADMINISTRATOR ACT, 1984 PA 218, MCL 550.901 TO 550.960.

2 (D) A NONPROFIT DENTAL CARE CORPORATION REGULATED UNDER 1963

3 PA 125, MCL 550.351 TO 550.373.
