January 20, 2010, Introduced by Senator BASHAM and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding part 69.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 PART 69 ENGINE IDLING
- 2 SEC. 6901. AS USED IN THIS PART:
- 3 (A) "LOAD/UNLOAD LOCATION" OR "LOCATION" MEANS A LOCATION
- 4 WHERE VEHICLES LOAD OR UNLOAD.
 - (B) "VEHICLE" MEANS A COMMERCIAL DIESEL VEHICLE THAT IS
 - DESIGNED TO OPERATE ON A HIGHWAY.
- SEC. 6903. THE OWNER OF A LOAD/UNLOAD LOCATION SHALL NOT CAUSE
- A VEHICLE TO IDLE FOR MORE THAN 30 TOTAL MINUTES WHILE WAITING TO
- 9 LOAD OR UNLOAD AT THE LOCATION.
- 10 SEC. 6905. THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A VEHICLE SHALL NOT CAUSE

- 1 OR PERMIT THE VEHICLE TO IDLE FOR MORE THAN 5 TOTAL MINUTES IN ANY
- 2 60-MINUTE PERIOD EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 6903 OR 6907.
- 3 SEC. 6907. SECTION 6905 DOES NOT APPLY UNDER ANY OF THE
- 4 FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

- 14 USED IN AN EMERGENCY CAPACITY IDLES WHILE USED IN AN EMERGENCY OR
- 15 TRAINING CAPACITY AND NOT FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF THE VEHICLE
- 16 OPERATOR.
- 17 (ii) ANY OTHER VEHICLE IDLES WHILE BEING USED IN AN EMERGENCY
- 18 CAPACITY AND NOT FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF THE VEHICLE OPERATOR.
- 19 (D) A VEHICLE'S PRIMARY PROPULSION ENGINE IDLES FOR
- 20 MAINTENANCE, SERVICING, REPAIRING, OR DIAGNOSTIC PURPOSES, IF
- 21 IDLING IS REQUIRED FOR SUCH ACTIVITY.
- 22 (E) A VEHICLE IDLES AS PART OF A STATE OR FEDERAL INSPECTION
- 23 TO VERIFY THAT ALL EQUIPMENT IS IN GOOD WORKING ORDER, IF IDLING IS
- 24 REQUIRED AS PART OF THE INSPECTION.
- 25 (F) IDLING OF THE PRIMARY PROPULSION ENGINE IS NECESSARY TO
- 26 POWER WORK-RELATED MECHANICAL OR ELECTRICAL OPERATIONS OTHER THAN
- 27 PROPULSION, SUCH AS MIXING OR PROCESSING CARGO OR STRAIGHT TRUCK

- 1 REFRIGERATION. THIS SUBDIVISION DOES NOT APPLY TO IDLING FOR CABIN
- 2 COMFORT OR THE OPERATION OF NONESSENTIAL ON-BOARD EQUIPMENT.
- 3 (G) AN ARMORED VEHICLE IDLES WHEN A PERSON REMAINS INSIDE THE
- 4 VEHICLE TO GUARD THE CONTENTS OR WHILE THE VEHICLE IS BEING LOADED
- 5 OR UNLOADED.
- 6 (H) A VEHICLE IDLES BECAUSE OF MECHANICAL DIFFICULTIES OVER
- 7 WHICH THE DRIVER HAS NO CONTROL AND THE VEHICLE OWNER, WITHIN 30
- 8 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING A CITATION UNDER SECTION 6913, SUBMITS BY MAIL
- 9 TO THE APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY THE REPAIR PAPERWORK
- 10 OR PRODUCT RECEIPT VERIFYING THAT THE MECHANICAL PROBLEM HAS BEEN
- 11 FIXED.
- 12 SEC. 6909. SECTIONS 6903 AND 6905 DO NOT PROHIBIT OPERATING AN
- 13 AUXILIARY POWER UNIT, GENERATOR SET, OR OTHER MOBILE IDLE REDUCTION
- 14 TECHNOLOGY AS A MEANS TO HEAT, AIR-CONDITION, OR PROVIDE ELECTRICAL
- 15 POWER AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO IDLING THE VEHICLE'S PRIMARY PROPULSION
- 16 ENGINE UNDER ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:
- 17 (A) THE VEHICLE IS EQUIPPED WITH A MODEL YEAR 2006 OR OLDER
- 18 ENGINE.
- 19 (B) THE VEHICLE IS EQUIPPED WITH A MODEL YEAR 2007 OR NEWER
- 20 ENGINE AND THE MOBILE IDLE REDUCTION TECHNOLOGY MEETS ANY OF THE
- 21 FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 22 (i) IS EQUIPPED WITH A VERIFIED LEVEL 3 IN-USE STRATEGY FOR
- 23 PARTICULATE MATTER CONTROL.
- 24 (ii) HAS ITS EXHAUST ROUTED DIRECTLY INTO THE VEHICLE'S EXHAUST
- 25 PIPE, UPSTREAM OF THE DIESEL PARTICULATE MATTER AFTERTREATMENT
- 26 DEVICE.
- 27 SEC. 6911. (1) A PERSON SHALL BE ISSUED A WARNING FOR A FIRST
