- 1 SEC. 1245. (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (4), NOT LATER THAN JUNE

- 5 NONINSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT SERVICES FOR THE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
- 6 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY. A SCHOOL

- 3 (4) THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION ARE SUBJECT TO ALL OF THE
