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## **SENATE BILL No. 1406**

June 29, 2010, Introduced by Senators BASHAM and ANDERSON and referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 12601 and 12603 (MCL 333.12601 and 333.12603), as amended by 2009 PA 188; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 12601. (1) As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Casino" means that term as defined in section 2 of the
- 3 Michigan gaming control and revenue act, 1996 IL 1, MCL 432.202.
- Casino does not include a casino operated under the Indian gaming
- 5 regulatory act, 25 USC 2701 to 2721.
  - (A) <del>(b)</del> "Child caring institution" and "child care center"
- 7 mean those terms as defined in section 1 of 1973 PA 116, MCL
- 8 722.111.
  - (B) (c) "Cigar" means any roll of tobacco weighing 3 or more

- 1 pounds per 1,000, which roll has a wrapper or cover consisting only
- 2 of tobacco.
- 3 (C) (d) "Cigar bar" means an establishment or area within an
- 4 establishment that is open to the public and is designated for the
- 5 smoking of cigars, purchased on the premises or elsewhere.
- 6 (D) (e)—"County medical care facility" means that term as
- 7 defined in section 20104.
- 8 (E) (f)—"Educational facility" means a building owned, leased,
- 9 or under the control of a public or private school system, college,
- 10 or university.
- 11 (F) (g) "Food service establishment" means a food service
- 12 establishment as defined in section 12905.
- (G) (h) "Health facility" means a health facility or agency
- 14 licensed under article 17, except a home for the aged, nursing
- 15 home, county medical care facility, hospice, or hospital long-term
- 16 care unit.
- 17 (H)  $\frac{(i)}{(i)}$  "Home for the aged" means that term as defined in
- **18** section 20106.
- 19 (I) <del>(j)</del> "Hospice" means that term as defined in section 20106.
- 20 (J)  $\frac{(k)}{(k)}$  "Hospital long-term care unit" means that term as
- 21 defined in section 20106.
- 22 (K)  $\frac{(l)}{l}$  "Meeting" means a meeting as defined in section 2 of
- 23 the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.262.
- 24 (l)  $\frac{m}{m}$  "Motor vehicle" means that term as defined in section
- 25 33 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.33.
- 26 (M) (n)—"Nursing home" means that term as defined in section
- **27** 20109.

- 1 (N) (o) "Place of employment" means an enclosed indoor area
- 2 that contains 1 or more work areas for 1 or more persons employed
- 3 by a public or private employer. Place of employment does not
- 4 include any of the following:
- 5 (i) A structure used primarily as the residence of the owner or
- 6 lessee that is also used as an office for the owner or lessee and
- 7 for no other employees.
- 8 (ii) A food service establishment that is subject to section
- **9** 12905.
- 10 (iii) A motor vehicle.
- 11 (0) (p) "Public body" means a public body as defined in
- 12 section 2 of the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.262.
- (P) (q) "Public place", except as otherwise provided in
- 14 subsection (2), means any of the following:
- 15 (i) An enclosed, indoor area owned or operated by a state or
- 16 local governmental agency and used by the general public or serving
- 17 as a meeting place for a public body, including an office,
- 18 educational facility, home for the aged, nursing home, county
- 19 medical care facility, hospice, hospital long-term care unit,
- 20 auditorium, arena, meeting room, or public conveyance.
- (ii) An enclosed, indoor area that is not owned or operated by
- 22 a state or local governmental agency, is used by the general
- 23 public, and is any of the following:
- 24 (A) An educational facility.
- 25 (B) A home for the aged, nursing home, county medical care
- 26 facility, hospice, or hospital long-term care unit.
- 27 (C) An auditorium.

- 1 (D) An arena.
- 2 (E) A theater.
- 3 (F) A museum.
- (G) A concert hall.
- (H) Any other facility during the period of its use for a 5
- performance or exhibit of the arts.
- 7 (iii) Unless otherwise exempt under this part, a place of
- 8 employment.

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- (Q) <del>(r)</del> "Smoking" or "smoke" means the burning of a lighted 9
- 10 cigar, cigarette, pipe, or any other matter or substance that
- 11 contains a tobacco product.
- 12 (R) <del>(s)</del> "Smoking paraphernalia" means any equipment,
- 13 apparatus, or furnishing that is used in or necessary for the
- 14 activity of smoking.
- (S) (t) "Tobacco product" means a product that contains 15
- 16 tobacco and is intended for human consumption, including, but not
- 17 limited to, cigarettes, noncigarette smoking tobacco, or smokeless
- 18 tobacco, as those terms are defined in section 2 of the tobacco
- 19 products tax act, 1993 PA 327, MCL 205.422, and cigars.
- 20 (T) (u) "Tobacco specialty retail store" means an
- 21 establishment in which the primary purpose is the retail sale of
- 22 tobacco products and smoking paraphernalia, and in which the sale
- 23 of other products is incidental. Tobacco specialty retail store
- 24 does not include a tobacco department or section of a larger
- 25 commercial establishment or any establishment with any type of
- 26 liquor, food, or restaurant license.
- 27 (U) <del>(v)</del> "Work area" means a site within a place of employment

- 1 at which 1 or more employees perform services for an employer.
- 2 (2) In addition, article 1 contains general definitions and
- 3 principles of construction applicable to all articles of this code.
- 4 Sec. 12603. (1) An individual shall not smoke in a public
- 5 place or at a meeting of a public body, and a state or local
- 6 governmental agency or the person who owns, operates, manages, or
- 7 is in control of a public place shall make a reasonable effort to
- 8 prohibit individuals from smoking in a public place.
- 9 (2) The owner, operator, manager, or person having control of
- 10 a public place OR a food service establishment or a casino
- 11 subject to section 12606b shall do all of the following:
- 12 (a) Clearly and conspicuously post "no smoking" signs or the
- 13 international "no smoking" symbol at the entrances to and in every
- 14 building or other area where smoking is prohibited under this act.
- 15 (b) Remove all ashtrays and other smoking paraphernalia from
- 16 anywhere smoking is prohibited under this act.
- 17 (c) Inform individuals smoking in violation of this act that
- 18 they are in violation of state law and subject to penalties.
- 19 (d) If applicable, refuse to serve an individual smoking in
- 20 violation of this act.
- 21 (e) Ask an individual smoking in violation of this act to
- 22 refrain from smoking and, if the individual continues to smoke in
- 23 violation of this act, ask him or her to leave the public place 7
- 24 OR food service establishment. , or nonsmoking area of the casino.
- 25 (3) The owner, operator, manager, or person in control of a
- 26 hotel, motel, or other lodging facility shall comply with
- 27 subsection (2) and section 12606. It is an affirmative defense to a

- 1 prosecution or civil or administrative action for a violation of
- 2 this section that the owner, operator, manager, or person in
- 3 control of a hotel, motel, or other lodging facility where smoking
- 4 is prohibited under this section made a good faith effort to
- 5 prohibit smoking by complying with subsection (2). To assert the
- 6 affirmative defense under this subsection, the owner, operator,
- 7 manager, or person shall file a sworn affidavit setting forth his
- 8 or her efforts to prohibit smoking and his or her actions of
- 9 compliance with subsection (2).
- 10 (4) This section may be referred to as the "Dr. Ron Davis
- **11** Law".
- 12 Enacting section 1. Section 12606b of the public health code,
- 13 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.12606b, is repealed.
- 14 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect May 1,
- **15** 2010.

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
