A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5940 AS INTRODUCED 11-13-14

House Bill 5940 would amend the Food Law (Public Act 92 of 2000) by increasing certain license and certificate fees contained within the act. It also would add compliance with rules promulgated under the act as a reason the director of the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD) conducts inspections.


The revised fee schedule is outlined below.

For a renewal application postmarked or delivered in person on or after May1 of each year, the department would impose a late fee of an additional \$150. Currently, the late fee is \$10 per business day the application is late. The current late fee applies to both renewal and new applications and so would the revised late fee.
