Senate Bill 617 (Substitute S-1 as reported)

Sponsor: Senator Jim Marleau Committee: Health Policy

CONTENT

The bill would create the "Michigan Brain Injury Law" as Part 52A of the Public Health Code to do the following:

- -- Establish the Michigan Brain Injury Services and Prevention Council in the Department of Community Health (DCH), and abolish the Traumatic Brain Injury Services and Prevention Council.
- -- Require the proposed Council to collaborate with the DCH to develop a comprehensive statewide plan to address the needs of individuals with acquired brain injury (ABI).
- -- Require the Council to submit to the DCH Director and the Legislature an annual report that included recommendations to address the needs of individuals with ABI.
- -- Require the DCH to coordinate services for individuals with ABI, and encourage and facilitate collaboration among entities that provide those services.
