 - (b) "Employer" means a person engaging in any activity, enterprise, or business in this state.
 - Sec. 3. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a county, township, city, or village shall not adopt or administer an ordinance or policy requiring an employer to provide an employee with paid or unpaid leave from employment that is not required

- 1 under federal law or the law of this state.
- 2 (2) This act does not prohibit an ordinance or policy
- 3 concerning leave or other absences of an employee of the county,
