A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 13524.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 13524. (1) A WRITTEN REPORT OF THE RESULTS OF A
- 2 MAMMOGRAPHY EXAMINATION CONDUCTED IN THIS STATE THAT IS SENT TO A
- 3 PHYSICIAN OR PATIENT PURSUANT TO 42 USC 263B SHALL INCLUDE THE
- 4 FINDINGS OF THE MAMMOGRAPHY INTERPRETER BASED UPON THE BREAST
- 5 IMAGING REPORTING AND DATA SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY THE AMERICAN
- 6 COLLEGE OF RADIOLOGY AND THE PATIENT'S BREAST DENSITY LEVEL BASED
- 7 UPON THE BREAST IMAGING REPORTING AND DATA SYSTEM BREAST DENSITY
- 8 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM. IF THE MAMMOGRAPHY INTERPRETER DETERMINES
- 9 THAT THE PATIENT HAS HETEROGENEOUSLY OR EXTREMELY DENSE BREAST
- 10 TISSUE, THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING NOTICE:

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- 1 "THE PHYSICIAN INTERPRETING THIS MAMMOGRAPHY EXAMINATION HAS
- 2 DETERMINED THAT THE PATIENT HAS DENSE BREAST TISSUE. MAMMOGRAPHY
- 3 HAS KNOWN LIMITATIONS AND, IN A PATIENT WHO HAS DENSE BREAST
- 4 TISSUE, SOME ABNORMALITIES MAY NOT APPEAR. THIS NOTICE IS INTENDED
- 5 TO RAISE AWARENESS AND PROMOTE DISCUSSION BETWEEN THE PATIENT AND
- 6 HIS OR HER PHYSICIAN REGARDING THE RESULTS OF THE MAMMOGRAPHY
- 7 EXAMINATION. DEPENDING UPON THE PATIENT'S INDIVIDUAL RISK FACTORS,
- 8 THE PHYSICIAN MAY RECOMMEND ADDITIONAL TESTS, INCLUDING AN
- 9 ULTRASOUND OR MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING. THE PATIENT AND PHYSICIAN
- 10 SHOULD DISCUSS ANY QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS REGARDING THE RESULTS OF
- 11 THE MAMMOGRAPHY EXAMINATION.".
- 12 (2) A SUMMARY OF THE WRITTEN REPORT OF THE RESULTS OF A
- 13 MAMMOGRAPHY EXAMINATION CONDUCTED IN THIS STATE THAT IS SENT
- 14 DIRECTLY TO A PATIENT PURSUANT TO 42 USC 263B SHALL INCLUDE THE
- 15 FINDINGS OF THE MAMMOGRAPHY INTERPRETER BASED UPON THE BREAST
- 16 IMAGING REPORTING AND DATA SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY THE AMERICAN
- 17 COLLEGE OF RADIOLOGY AND THE PATIENT'S BREAST DENSITY LEVEL BASED
- 18 UPON THE BREAST IMAGING REPORTING AND DATA SYSTEM BREAST DENSITY
- 19 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM. IF THE MAMMOGRAPHY INTERPRETER DETERMINES
- 20 THAT THE PATIENT HAS HETEROGENEOUSLY OR EXTREMELY DENSE BREAST
- 21 TISSUE, THE SUMMARY SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING NOTICE:
- 22 "THE PHYSICIAN INTERPRETING YOUR MAMMOGRAPHY EXAMINATION HAS
- 23 DETERMINED THAT YOU HAVE DENSE BREAST TISSUE. MAMMOGRAPHY HAS KNOWN
- 24 LIMITATIONS AND, IN A PATIENT WHO HAS DENSE BREAST TISSUE, SOME
- 25 ABNORMALITIES MAY NOT APPEAR. IF YOU WERE REFERRED TO US BY A
- 26 PHYSICIAN, A WRITTEN REPORT OF THE RESULTS OF YOUR MAMMOGRAPHY
- 27 EXAMINATION, INCLUDING INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR BREAST DENSITY, HAS

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- 1 BEEN SENT TO YOUR PHYSICIAN. THIS NOTICE IS INTENDED TO RAISE YOUR
- 2 AWARENESS AND PROMOTE DISCUSSION BETWEEN YOU AND YOUR PHYSICIAN
- 3 REGARDING THE RESULTS OF YOUR MAMMOGRAPHY EXAMINATION. DEPENDING
- 4 UPON YOUR INDIVIDUAL RISK FACTORS, YOUR PHYSICIAN MAY RECOMMEND
- 5 ADDITIONAL TESTS INCLUDING AN ULTRASOUND OR MAGNETIC RESONANCE
- 6 IMAGING. YOU SHOULD CONTACT YOUR PHYSICIAN IF YOU HAVE ANY
- 7 QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS REGARDING THE RESULTS OF YOUR MAMMOGRAPHY
- 8 EXAMINATION.".
