THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

provisions of this act shall, unless herein otherwise provided, be
punished by a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00, or by imprisonment in
the state prison for a term not exceeding 5 years, or by both such
fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.EXCEPT AS
OTHERWISE PROVIDED, A PERSON CONVICTED OF PERJURY UNDER THIS ACT IS
GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 5
YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.
