HOUSE BILL No. 4594

April 18, 2013, Introduced by Reps. Tlaib, Roberts, Darany, Hovey-Wright, Haugh, Brown, Cochran, Kivela, Santana, Muxlow, Knezek, Banks, Dillon, Talabi, Stallworth, Hobbs, Kosowski, Townsend, Zemke, Stanley, Geiss, LaVoy, Durhal, Kandrevas, Zorn, Outman, Faris, Greimel and Oakes and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2008 PA 429, entitled "Nonferrous metal regulatory act," by amending the title and sections 1, 3, and 5 (MCL 445.421, 445.423, and 445.425).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

An act to regulate the purchase and sale of certain nonferrous metals; to provide for disclosures by certain persons regarding certain transactions; to require the creation of records for certain purposes and for the use of certain databases by certain persons; SCRAP METAL AND OTHER ITEMS THAT CONTAIN FERROUS OR NONFERROUS METAL TO SCRAP METAL DEALERS; TO REQUIRE SELLERS TO PROVIDE AND SCRAP METAL DEALERS TO OBTAIN CERTAIN INFORMATION AT THE TIME OF A PURCHASE TRANSACTION; TO REQUIRE THAT SCRAP METAL

- 1 DEALERS IMPLEMENT AND MAINTAIN RECORDS OF THEIR PURCHASE
- 2 TRANSACTIONS AND TO MAKE THOSE RECORDS AVAILABLE FOR LAW
- 3 ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES; and to provide for penalties and remedies.
- 4 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 5 "nonferrous "SCRAP metal regulatory act".
- 6 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 7 (a) "Dealer" means any person that is not a first purchaser
- 8 who purchases nonferrous metals from any seller. Dealer includes,
- 9 but is not limited to, a person, whether or not licensed under
- 10 state law or local ordinance, that operates a business as a scrap
- 11 metal recycler, scrap processor, secondhand and junk dealer, or
- 12 other person who purchases any amount of nonferrous metal on a
- 13 regular, sporadic, or 1-time basis. Dealer does not include an
- 14 automotive recycler regulated by and complying with section 217 of
- the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.217; section 18 of
- 16 the motor vehicle service and repair act, 1974 PA 300, MCL
- 17 257.1318; or section 2 of 1986 PA 119, MCL 257.1352, when engaging
- 18 in activities that meet the definition of automotive recycler as
- 19 defined in section 2a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300,
- 20 MCL 257.2a.
- 21 (b) "Documentation" means a signed statement that indicates
- 22 where the person obtained the article, that the person is
- 23 authorized to sell the article, or other evidence that reasonably
- 24 demonstrates ownership of the article and the source of the
- 25 article.
- 26 (A) (c) "Ferrous metal" means a metal that contains
- 27 significant quantities of iron or steel.

- 1 (B) (d) "First purchaser" means the first buyer of a
- 2 manufactured product containing ITEM THAT CONTAINS FERROUS OR
- 3 nonferrous metal in a retail or business-to-business transaction.
- 4 Persons purchasing nonferrous metal A PERSON THAT PURCHASES SCRAP
- 5 METAL, OR OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 10, in
- 6 violation of this act, OR AN automotive recyclers, pawnshops,
- 7 RECYCLER, PAWNSHOP, scrap metal recyclers, and RECYCLER, OR scrap
- 8 processors are PROCESSOR IS not considered A first
- 9 purchasers.PURCHASER.
- 10 (C) "GOVERNMENTAL UNIT" MEANS A SUBDIVISION, AGENCY,
- 11 DEPARTMENT, COUNTY, PARISH, MUNICIPALITY, OR OTHER UNIT OF THE
- 12 GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES, THIS STATE, ANOTHER STATE, OR A
- 13 FOREIGN COUNTRY.
- 14 (D) (e) "Industrial or commercial account CUSTOMER" means any
- 15 person, operating A PERSON THAT OPERATES from a fixed location 7
- 16 that AND is a seller of ferrous or nonferrous SCRAP metal to a
- 17 scrap metal recycler pursuant to DEALER UNDER a written agreement.
- 18 (E) (f)—"Nonferrous metal" means a metal that does not contain
- 19 significant quantities of ferrous metal but contains copper, brass,
- 20 platinum-based metals, aluminum, bronze, lead, zinc, nickel, or
- 21 alloys of those metals.
- 22 (F) (g) "Person" means an individual, partnership,
- 23 corporation, limited liability company, joint venture, trust,
- 24 association, or other legal entity.
- 25 (G) (h) "Public fixtures FIXTURE" means articles containing
- 26 nonferrous metal that are used or located in areas open to the
- 27 public and include, but are not limited to, utility access covers;

- 1 street light and fixtures; road and bridge guard rails; highway or
- 2 street signs; water meter covers; traffic directional and control
- 3 signs; traffic light signals; telecommunications cable; utility-
- 4 related articles; and historical markers. AN ITEM THAT CONTAINS
- 5 FERROUS OR NONFERROUS METAL AND IS OWNED OR UNDER THE EXCLUSIVE
- 6 CONTROL OF A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT. THE TERM INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT
- 7 LIMITED TO, A STREET LIGHT POLE OR FIXTURE, ROAD OR BRIDGE
- 8 GUARDRAIL, TRAFFIC SIGN, TRAFFIC LIGHT SIGNAL, OR HISTORICAL
- 9 MARKER.
- 10 (H) "PURCHASE TRANSACTION" MEANS A PURCHASE OF SCRAP METAL BY
- 11 A SCRAP METAL DEALER. THE TERM DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY OF THE
- 12 FOLLOWING:
- 13 (i) THE PURCHASE OF 1 OR MORE USED OR SECONDHAND, DISTRESSED,
- 14 OR SALVAGE VEHICLES OR VEHICLE PARTS BY A USED OR SECONDHAND
- 15 VEHICLE DEALER OR USED OR SECONDHAND VEHICLE PARTS DEALER THAT IS
- 16 LICENSED AS A DEALER UNDER SECTION 248 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE
- 17 CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.248, AND IS ACTING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF
- 18 THAT DEALER'S LICENSE.
- 19 (ii) THE PURCHASE OF 1 OR MORE USED OR SECONDHAND, DISTRESSED,
- 20 OR SALVAGE VEHICLES, VEHICLE PARTS, OR VEHICLE SCRAP BY A VEHICLE
- 21 SCRAP METAL PROCESSOR, VEHICLE SALVAGE POOL OPERATOR, OR FOREIGN
- 22 SALVAGE VEHICLE DEALER THAT IS LICENSED AS A DEALER UNDER SECTION
- 23 248 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.248, AND IS
- 24 ACTING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THAT DEALER'S LICENSE.
- 25 (iii) THE PURCHASE OF 1 OR MORE USED OR SECONDHAND, DISTRESSED,
- 26 OR SALVAGE VEHICLES, VEHICLE PARTS, OR VEHICLE SCRAP BY AN
- 27 AUTOMOTIVE RECYCLER THAT IS LICENSED AS A DEALER UNDER SECTION 248

- 1 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.248, IF THE
- 2 TRANSACTION IS AUTHORIZED UNDER SECTION 217C OF THE MICHIGAN
- 3 VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.217C; SECTION 18 OF THE MOTOR
- 4 VEHICLE SERVICE AND REPAIR ACT, 1974 PA 300, MCL 257.1318; OR
- 5 SECTION 2 OF 1986 PA 119, MCL 257.1352.
- 6 (iv) THE PURCHASE OF SCRAP METAL BY A MILL, FOUNDRY, DIE
- 7 CASTER, OR OTHER MANUFACTURING FACILITY THAT PURCHASES SCRAP METAL
- 8 FOR ITS OWN USE IN THE PRODUCTION OF METAL ARTICLES OR MATERIALS
- 9 AND DOES NOT IN THE ORDINARY COURSE OF ITS BUSINESS PURCHASE SCRAP
- 10 METAL FOR RESALE.
- 11 (i) "Record" means a paper, electronic, or other generally
- 12 accepted method of storing information in a retrievable form.
- 13 (J) "SCALE OPERATOR" MEANS THE EMPLOYEE OF A SCRAP METAL
- 14 DEALER WHO OPERATES OR ATTENDS A SCALE THAT IS USED TO WEIGH THE
- 15 SCRAP METAL IN A PURCHASE TRANSACTION.
- 16 (K) "SCRAP METAL" MEANS FERROUS OR NONFERROUS METAL, OR ITEMS
- 17 THAT CONTAIN FERROUS OR NONFERROUS METAL, THAT ARE SOLD OR OFFERED
- 18 FOR SALE FOR THE VALUE OF THE FERROUS OR NONFERROUS METAL THEY
- 19 CONTAIN RATHER THAN THEIR ORIGINAL INTENDED USE; FERROUS OR
- 20 NONFERROUS METAL REMOVED FROM OR OBTAINED BY CUTTING, DEMOLISHING,
- 21 OR DISASSEMBLING A BUILDING, STRUCTURE, OR MANUFACTURED ITEM; OR
- 22 OTHER METAL THAT CANNOT BE USED FOR ITS ORIGINAL INTENDED PURPOSE
- 23 BUT CAN BE PROCESSED FOR REUSE IN A MILL, FOUNDRY, DIE CASTER, OR
- 24 OTHER MANUFACTURING FACILITY.
- 25 (1) "SCRAP METAL DEALER" MEANS A PERSON THAT BUYS OR SELLS
- 26 SCRAP METAL AND IS NOT A FIRST PURCHASER. THE TERM INCLUDES, BUT IS
- 27 NOT LIMITED TO, A PERSON, WHETHER OR NOT LICENSED UNDER STATE LAW

- 1 OR LOCAL ORDINANCE, THAT OPERATES A BUSINESS AS A SCRAP METAL
- 2 RECYCLER, SCRAP PROCESSOR, SECONDHAND AND JUNK DEALER, OR OTHER
- 3 PERSON THAT PURCHASES ANY AMOUNT OF SCRAP METAL ON A REGULAR,
- 4 SPORADIC, OR 1-TIME BASIS. THE TERM DOES NOT INCLUDE A GOVERNMENTAL
- 5 UNIT THAT BUYS OR SELLS SCRAP METAL.
- 6 (M) (i)—"Scrap metal recycler" means a person that purchases
- 7 FERROUS OR nonferrous metal that is intended for recycling or
- 8 reuse, whether regarded as a scrap processor, core buyer, or other
- 9 similar business operation.
- 10 (N) (k)—"Scrap processor" means that term as defined in
- 11 section 3 of 1917 PA 350, MCL 445.403.
- 12 (0) (1) "Seller" means any individual or A person that either
- 13 regularly, sporadically, or on a 1-time basis receives
- 14 consideration from any other person from the purchase by a SCRAP
- 15 METAL dealer of nonferrous—SCRAP metal offered by that seller.
- 16 Sec. 5. (1) A dealer shall do all ALL of the following APPLY
- 17 TO A SCRAP METAL DEALER:
- 18 (a) Produce and maintain records as required under section
- 19 $\frac{7(2)}{}$.
- 20 (b) Participate in a database meeting the requirements of
- 21 section 11.
- 22 (c) Tag and hold any nonferrous metal as provided for in
- 23 section 9.
- 24 (d) Pay a seller by a method capable of being traced from the
- 25 dealer to the seller. Payment by cash or currency of more than
- 26 \$50.00, barter, or trade is not considered a payment that complies
- 27 with the requirement of this subdivision. Payment of cash in any

- 1 amount in a transaction involving predominantly copper articles is
- 2 considered a violation of this subdivision.
- 3 (e) In the case of a transaction involving nonferrous metal,
- 4 verify that the seller is at least 16 years of age.
- 5 (A) UNLESS SUBDIVISION (B) APPLIES, AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN
- 6 SUBDIVISION (C), A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL ONLY PAY A SELLER WITH
- 7 1 OF THE FOLLOWING IN A PURCHASE TRANSACTION:
- 8 (i) A CHECK OR MONEY ORDER. A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL MAKE AND
- 9 RETAIN A PHOTOGRAPH OR DIGITAL OR ELECTRONIC IMAGE OF THE DELIVERY
- 10 OF THE CHECK OR MONEY ORDER TO THE SELLER OR INDIVIDUAL ACTING ON
- 11 BEHALF OF THE SELLER IN THE PURCHASE TRANSACTION.
- 12 (ii) AN ELECTRONIC PAYMENT CARD OR ENCRYPTED RECEIPT THAT MAY
- 13 ONLY BE CONVERTED TO CASH IN AN AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE THAT IS
- 14 LOCATED ON THE SELLER'S PREMISES; IS USED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF
- 15 DISPENSING CASH IN CONNECTION WITH PURCHASE TRANSACTIONS; AND
- 16 PROVIDES A DIGITAL OR ELECTRONIC IMAGE OF THE DISPENSING OF THE
- 17 CASH TO THE SELLER.
- 18 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (C), IN A PURCHASE
- 19 TRANSACTION OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS, A SCRAP METAL DEALER
- 20 SHALL NOT PAY THE SELLER UNTIL 3 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF
- 21 THE TRANSACTION, AND SHALL ONLY PAY THE SELLER AFTER THAT PERIOD BY
- 22 MAKING A DIRECT DEPOSIT OR ELECTRONIC TRANSFER TO THE SELLER'S
- 23 ACCOUNT AT A FINANCIAL INSTITUTION OR MAILING A CHECK OR MONEY
- 24 ORDER, PAYABLE TO THE SELLER, TO A STREET ADDRESS PROVIDED TO THE
- 25 DEALER BY THE SELLER AND NOT TO A POST OFFICE BOX:
- 26 (i) CATALYTIC CONVERTERS, UNLESS THE SELLER IS AN AUTOMOTIVE
- 27 RECYCLER AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2A OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE,

- 1 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.2A.
- 2 (ii) AIR CONDITIONERS, AIR CONDITIONER EVAPORATOR COILS OR
- 3 CONDENSERS, OR PARTS OF AIR CONDITIONER EVAPORATOR COILS AND
- 4 CONDENSERS.
- 5 (iii) COPPER WIRE, INCLUDING COPPER WIRE THAT IS BURNED IN WHOLE
- 6 OR IN PART TO REMOVE THE INSULATION.
- 7 (C) IN A PURCHASE TRANSACTION WITH AN INDUSTRIAL OR BUSINESS
- 8 CUSTOMER, A SCRAP METAL DEALER MAY PAY THAT CUSTOMER IN ANY MANNER
- 9 DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (A) OR (B).
- 10 (D) UNLESS THE TRANSACTION IS WITH AN INDUSTRIAL OR COMMERCIAL
- 11 CUSTOMER, A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL NOT ACCEPT BARTER OR A TRADE
- 12 OR EXCHANGE OF SCRAP METAL OR OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY.
- 13 (E) A SCRAP METAL DEALER IN A PURCHASE TRANSACTION SHALL
- 14 EXAMINE THE IDENTIFICATION PRESENTED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) (A) BY THE
- 15 SELLER OR INDIVIDUAL ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE SELLER, AND IF THE
- 16 IDENTIFICATION PRESENTED DISPLAYS THE DATE OF BIRTH OF THE
- 17 INDIVIDUAL, CONFIRM THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD
- 18 BASED ON THAT DATE OF BIRTH.
- 19 (F) A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL NOT PURCHASE SCRAP METAL THAT
- 20 IS NOT DELIVERED IN OR ON A VEHICLE LICENSED AND TITLED FOR USE ON
- 21 PUBLIC HIGHWAYS.
- 22 (G) A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL ENSURE THAT IT TRAINS EACH
- 23 SCALE OPERATOR, PURCHASER, AND SUPERVISOR EMPLOYED BY THE DEALER
- 24 CONCERNING THE LEGAL REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ACT AND THE
- 25 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SCRAP METAL DEALER UNDER THIS ACT.
- 26 (2) A seller shall do all of the following: IN A PURCHASE
- 27 TRANSACTION, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO A SELLER, IF THE SELLER

- 1 IS AN INDIVIDUAL, OR TO AN INDIVIDUAL ACTING AS AN AGENT OR
- 2 REPRESENTATIVE OF A SELLER:
- 3 (a) Present to the dealer an HE OR SHE MUST PRESENT HIS OR HER
- 4 operator's or chauffeur's license, military identification card,
- 5 Michigan identification card, passport, or other government-issued
- 6 identification containing a—HIS OR HER photograph TO THE SCRAP
- 7 METAL DEALER and allow the SCRAP METAL dealer to make a photocopy
- 8 or electronic copy of the identification.
- 9 (b) Allow HE OR SHE MUST ALLOW the SCRAP METAL dealer to make
- 10 a—TAKE HIS OR HER thumbprint, to be used only for identification
- 11 purposes by the SCRAP METAL dealer and for investigation purposes
- 12 by a law enforcement agency.
- 13 (c) Execute HE OR SHE MUST PROVIDE THE SCRAP METAL DEALER WITH
- 14 a signed statement indicating that the seller CERTIFIES THAT HE OR
- 15 SHE is the owner of, or is otherwise authorized to sell, the
- 16 nonferrous SCRAP metal offered for purchase to the SCRAP METAL
- 17 dealer.
- 18 (d) Attest to the lack of any criminal convictions—AN
- 19 INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A CRIME involving the theft,
- 20 conversion, or sale of nonferrous metals.SCRAP METAL MAY NOT ENTER
- 21 INTO A PURCHASE TRANSACTION. AS PART OF A PURCHASE TRANSACTION, THE
- 22 INDIVIDUAL SHALL CERTIFY THAT HE OR SHE HAS NOT BEEN CONVICTED OF A
- 23 CRIME DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBDIVISION.
- 24 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 25 unless both of the following bills of the 97th Legislature are
