A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 11c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 11C. (1) SUBSECTION (2) APPLIES TO A SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT
- 2 MEETS BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) THE DISTRICT IS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A DEFICIT ELIMINATION
- 4 PLAN UNDER SECTION 102 OF THE STATE SCHOOL AID ACT, MCL 388.1702,
- 5 AND EITHER HAS FAILED TO SUBMIT A DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN UNDER
- 6 THAT SECTION OR HAS SUBMITTED A DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN UNDER THAT
- 7 SECTION BUT THAT PLAN HAS NOT BEEN APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT
- 8 WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER IT WAS SUBMITTED.
