A bill to amend 1968 PA 330, entitled "Private security business and security alarm act," by amending section 17 (MCL 338.1067), as amended by 2010 PA 68.

- 1 Sec. 17. (1) A licensee may employ as many persons INDIVIDUALS

- 16 CROSS, AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, OR A COMPARABLE ORGANIZATION OR

- 18 (4) (3)—A licensee shall keep and maintain in this state
- 19 adequate and complete personnel information on all persons employed
- 20 by him or her. EMPLOYEES OF THE LICENSEE. A complete employee
- 21 roster in a manner described by the department shall be filed with
- 22 the department by each licensee on a quarterly basis. The rosters
- 23 must be filed with the department by April 15, July 15, October 15,
