March 5, 2014, Introduced by Reps. Haines, Haveman, Lori, Schor, Stallworth, Cavanagh, Slavens, Segal, LaVoy, Potvin, Heise and Yanez and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1915 PA 31, entitled

"Youth tobacco act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 722.644), as amended by 2006 PA 236, and by adding section 2b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 2B. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL IN THIS STATE AN
- 2 ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE OR OTHER SIMILAR PRODUCT THAT RELIES ON
- 3 VAPORIZATION OR AEROSOLIZATION OF NICOTINE, OR A COMPONENT OF ANY
- 4 OF THESE, UNLESS THE DEVICE, PRODUCT, OR COMPONENT IS PACKAGED IN A
- CHILD-RESISTANT CONTAINER THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE POISON
- PREVENTION PACKAGING ACT OF 1970, PUBLIC LAW 91-601, AND OF 16 CFR
- PART 1700.
- 8 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A
- MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$50.00 FOR EACH

- 1 SNUFF, SNUS, OR ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES OR OTHER SIMILAR
- 2 PRODUCTS THAT RELY ON VAPORIZATION OR AEROSOLIZATION. TOBACCO
- 3 PRODUCT INCLUDES A COMPONENT PART OF A TOBACCO PRODUCT REGARDLESS

- 9 (F) (e) "Use a tobacco product" means to smoke, chew, suck,
- inhale, or otherwise consume a tobacco product.
