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## **HOUSE BILL No. 5560**

May 8, 2014, Introduced by Reps. Price, VerHeulen, Schor and Rutledge and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to set forth the methods for local governments and other governmental entities to provide public notices; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain public entities; and to prescribe the duties of certain private entities.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "local
  qovernment public notice act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Internet" means that term as defined in 47 USC 230.
  - (b) "Local media outlet" means a television station or radio broadcast station, licensed by the federal communications commission.
  - (c) "Required area" means the county, city, township, village, district, or other geographic territory where the notice is

- 1 required to be published or posted.
- 2 (d) "Website" means a collection of pages of the internet,
- 3 usually in HTML format, with clickable or hypertext links to enable
- 4 navigation from 1 page or section to another, that often uses
- 5 associated graphics files to provide illustration and may contain
- 6 other clickable or hypertext links.
- 7 Sec. 3. Except as otherwise provided in sections 4 and 5, as
- 8 used in this act, "newspaper" means a print publication that is
- 9 published for the dissemination of local news of a general
- 10 character or for the dissemination of legal news and to which all
- 11 of the following apply:
- 12 (a) The print publication is published and distributed in not
- 13 less than weekly intervals.
- 14 (b) Not less than 50% of the words in the print publication
- 15 are in the English language.
- 16 (c) The print publication has a bona fide list of subscribers
- 17 in 1 or more counties in this state or is available to the public
- 18 at newsstands or other retail locations in 1 or more counties in
- 19 this state, or both.
- 20 (d) The print publication accepts and publishes official and
- 21 other notices.
- (e) The print publication regularly contains information of a
- 23 public character or of interest or value to residents, property
- 24 owners, or the general public.
- 25 (f) The print publication has been published or distributed
- 26 for not less than 1 year.
- 27 Sec. 4. If there is no publication that meets the definition

- 1 in section 3 published and of general circulation in the required
- 2 area, "newspaper" means a website on the internet that meets all of
- 3 the following requirements:
- 4 (a) The website is identified as a continuing online version
- 5 of a publication that previously met the definition in section 3
- 6 and was published and of general circulation in the required area.
- 7 (b) The website is published in the English language for the
- 8 dissemination of local news of a general character or for the
- 9 dissemination of legal news for the required area.
- 10 (c) The website has been established and operating without
- 11 interruption for at least 2 years.
- 12 (d) News content on the website is published and posted and
- 13 was updated at least every 7 days for the preceding 2 years.
- 14 (e) The website lists all of the following:
- 15 (i) Contact information, including a list of staff located in
- 16 the required area.
- (ii) An address and telephone number in the required area.
- 18 (iii) An address in the required area where the public notices
- 19 may be sent for posting.
- (iv) An address in the required area where complaints can be
- **21** made.
- (v) An address in the required area where printed copies of
- 23 notices may be viewed by the public.
- 24 (f) The website includes a clearly designated area for public
- 25 notices that is accessible via a prominently displayed and clearly
- 26 labeled link from the homepage of the website and the posted
- 27 notices are maintained permanently in a searchable database

- 1 accessible on the website.
- 2 (g) A majority of visitors to the website are residents of the
- 3 required area.
- 4 Sec. 5. If there is no publication or website that meets the
- 5 definition in section 3 or 4 in the required area, "newspaper"
- 6 means a publication or website in an adjoining county, city,
- 7 township, village, district, or other geographic territory, as
- 8 applicable, that meets the definition in section 3 or 4.
- 9 Sec. 6. (1) Except as otherwise provided in section 10, and
- 10 subject to section 11, beginning January 1, 2015 and until December
- 11 31, 2019, a local government or other governmental entity required
- 12 to provide public notice under this act shall provide that public
- 13 notice as follows:
- 14 (a) For tier A public notice, the notice shall be published
- 15 twice in a newspaper in the required area and may be posted on the
- 16 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 30
- **17** days.
- 18 (b) For tier A public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 19 published twice in a newspaper in the required area with a summary
- 20 of the document involved as well as a statement indicating a
- 21 location where copies of the full document involved are available
- 22 for public inspection. In addition, the notice may be posted on the
- 23 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 30
- 24 days with a link to the full document involved.
- 25 (c) For tier B public notice, the notice shall be published
- 26 once in a newspaper in the required area and may be posted on the
- 27 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 14

- 1 days.
- 2 (d) For tier B public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 3 published once in a newspaper in the required area with a summary
- 4 of the document involved as well as a statement indicating a
- 5 location where copies of the full document involved are available
- 6 for public inspection. In addition, the notice may be posted on the
- 7 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 14
- 8 days with a link to the full document involved.
- 9 (e) Except as otherwise provided in section 9, for tier C
- 10 public notice, the notice shall be posted on the active notice
- 11 portion of the website of the required area for 14 days. If the
- 12 local government or other governmental entity does not have a
- 13 website, the notice shall be published once in a newspaper in the
- 14 required area.
- 15 (2) In addition to the notice requirements under subsection
- 16 (1), a printed copy of the notice required under subsection (1)
- 17 shall be made available for public inspection by the local
- 18 government or other governmental entity for the duration of time
- 19 that the notice is required under subsection (1).
- Sec. 7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in section 9 or 10,
- 21 and subject to section 11, beginning January 1, 2020 and until
- 22 December 31, 2024, a local government or other governmental entity
- 23 required to provide public notice under this act shall provide that
- 24 public notice as follows:
- 25 (a) For tier A public notice, the notice shall be published
- 26 once in a newspaper in the required area and shall be posted on the
- 27 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 30

- 1 days. If the local government or other governmental entity does not
- 2 have a website, the notice shall be published twice in a newspaper
- 3 in the required area.
- 4 (b) For tier A public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 5 published once in a newspaper in the required area with a summary
- 6 of the document involved as well as a statement indicating a
- 7 location where copies of the full document involved are available
- 8 for public inspection and shall be posted on the active notice
- 9 portion of the website of the required area for 30 days with a link
- 10 to the full document involved. If the local government or other
- 11 governmental entity does not have a website, the notice shall be
- 12 published twice in a newspaper in the required area with a summary
- 13 of the document involved as well as a statement indicating a
- 14 location where copies of the full document involved are available
- 15 for public inspection.
- 16 (c) For tier B public notice, the notice shall be posted on
- 17 the active notice portion of the website of the required area for
- 18 14 days. If the local government or other governmental entity does
- 19 not have a website, the notice shall be published once in a
- 20 newspaper in the required area.
- 21 (d) For tier B public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 22 posted on the active notice portion of the website of the required
- 23 area for 14 days with a link to the full document involved. If the
- 24 local government or other governmental entity does not have a
- 25 website, the notice shall be published once in a newspaper in the
- 26 required area with a summary of the document involved as well as a
- 27 statement indicating a location where copies of the full document

- 1 involved are available for public inspection.
- 2 (e) For tier C public notice, the notice shall be posted on
- 3 the active notice portion of the website of the required area for
- 4 14 days. If the local government or other governmental entity does
- 5 not have a website, the notice shall be published once in a
- 6 newspaper in the required area.
- 7 (2) In addition to the notice requirements under subsection
- 8 (1), a printed copy of the notice required under subsection (1)
- 9 shall be made available for public inspection by the local
- 10 government or other governmental entity for the duration of time
- 11 that the notice is required under subsection (1).
- Sec. 8. (1) Except as otherwise provided in section 9 or 10,
- 13 and subject to section 11, beginning January 1, 2025, a local
- 14 government or other governmental entity required to provide public
- 15 notice under this act shall provide that public notice as follows:
- 16 (a) For tier A public notice, the notice shall be posted on
- 17 the active notice portion of the website of the required area for
- **18** 30 days.
- 19 (b) For tier A public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 20 posted on the active notice portion of the website of the required
- 21 area for 30 days with a link to the full document involved.
- (c) For tier B public notice, the notice shall be posted on
- 23 the active notice portion of the website of the required area for
- 24 14 days.
- 25 (d) For tier B public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 26 posted on the active notice portion of the website of the required
- 27 area for 14 days with a link to the full document involved.

- 1 (e) For tier C public notice, the notice shall be posted on
- 2 the active notice portion of the website of the required area for
- 3 14 days.
- 4 (2) In addition to the notice requirements under subsection
- 5 (1), a printed copy of the notice required under subsection (1)
- 6 shall be made available for public inspection by the local
- 7 government or other governmental entity for the duration of time
- 8 that the notice is required under subsection (1).
- 9 Sec. 9. (1) Upon receipt of a written petition signed by not
- 10 less than 10% of the registered electors of a local government, the
- 11 governing body of that local government shall submit the question
- 12 of requiring that public notices be provided in a newspaper for 5
- 13 years to the registered electors of that local government at the
- 14 next general November election.
- 15 (2) Subject to section 11, if a majority of the registered
- 16 electors voting on the question vote in favor of requiring that
- 17 public notices be provided in a newspaper for 5 years, the local
- 18 government shall provide public notice as follows:
- 19 (a) For tier A public notice, the notice shall be published
- 20 twice in a newspaper in the required area and may be posted on the
- 21 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 30
- 22 days.
- 23 (b) For tier A public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 24 published twice in a newspaper in the required area with a summary
- 25 of the document involved as well as a statement indicating a
- 26 location where copies of the full document involved are available
- 27 for public inspection. In addition, the notice may be posted on the

- 1 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 30
- 2 days with a link to the full document involved.
- 3 (c) For tier B public notice, the notice shall be published
- 4 once in a newspaper in the required area and may be posted on the
- 5 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 14
- 6 days.
- 7 (d) For tier B public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 8 published once in a newspaper in the required area with a summary
- 9 of the document involved as well as a statement indicating a
- 10 location where copies of the full document involved are available
- 11 for public inspection. In addition, the notice may be posted on the
- 12 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 14
- 13 days with a link to the full document involved.
- (e) For tier C public notice, the notice shall be published
- 15 once in a newspaper in the required area and may be posted on the
- 16 active notice portion of the website of the required area for 14
- **17** days.
- 18 (3) In addition to the notice required under subsection (2), a
- 19 printed copy of the notice required under subsection (2) shall be
- 20 made available for public inspection by the local government for
- 21 the duration of time that the notice is required under subsection
- **22** (2).
- 23 (4) A petition under this section, including the circulation
- 24 and signing of the petition, is subject to section 488 of the
- 25 Michigan election law, 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.488. A person who
- 26 violates a provision of the Michigan election law, 1954 PA 116, MCL
- 27 168.1 to 168.992, applicable to a petition described in this

- 1 section is subject to the penalties for a violation in the Michigan
- 2 election law, 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.1 to 168.992.
- 3 (5) As used in this section only, "newspaper" means a print
- 4 publication that is published for the dissemination of local news
- 5 of a general character or for the dissemination of legal news and
- 6 to which all of the following apply:
- 7 (a) The print publication is published and distributed in not
- 8 less than weekly intervals.
- 9 (b) Not less than 50% of the words in the print publication
- 10 are in the English language.
- 11 (c) The print publication has a bona fide list of subscribers
- 12 in 1 or more counties in this state or is available to the public
- 13 at newsstands or other retail locations in 1 or more counties in
- 14 this state, or both.
- 15 (d) The print publication accepts and publishes official and
- 16 other notices.
- 17 (e) The print publication regularly contains information of a
- 18 public character or of interest or value to residents, property
- 19 owners, or the general public.
- 20 (f) The print publication has been published or distributed
- 21 for not less than 1 year.
- 22 Sec. 10. (1) Except as otherwise provided in section 9, if a
- 23 local government or other governmental entity required to provide
- 24 public notice under this act enters into a contract with a local
- 25 media outlet regarding the provision of public notice, then the
- 26 local government or other governmental entity shall provide public
- 27 notice as follows:

- 1 (a) For tier A public notice, the notice shall be posted on
- 2 the active notice portion of the website of the local media outlet
- **3** for 30 days.
- 4 (b) For tier A public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 5 posted on the active notice portion of the website of the local
- 6 media outlet for 30 days with a link to the full document involved.
- 7 (c) For tier B public notice, the notice shall be posted on
- 8 the active notice portion of the website of the local media outlet
- 9 for 14 days.
- 10 (d) For tier B public notice with a link, the notice shall be
- 11 posted on the active notice portion of the website of the local
- 12 media outlet for 14 days with a link to the full document involved.
- 13 (e) For tier C public notice, the notice shall be posted on
- 14 the active notice portion of the website of the local media outlet
- **15** for 14 days.
- 16 (2) In addition to the notice requirements under subsection
- 17 (1), both of the following apply:
- 18 (a) The local media outlet shall, at least once each day
- 19 during its peak listening or viewing hours, make a general
- 20 broadcast or transmission indicating that public notices may be
- 21 found on the website of the local media outlet.
- (b) A printed copy of the notice required under subsection (1)
- 23 shall be made available for public inspection by the local
- 24 government or other governmental entity for the duration of time
- 25 that the notice is required under subsection (1).
- 26 (3) If a local government or other governmental entity
- 27 provides public notice under this section and that local government

- 1 or other governmental entity has a website, the local government or
- 2 other governmental entity shall provide a link on its website's
- 3 homepage to the active notice portion of the website of the local
- 4 media outlet.
- 5 Sec. 11. (1) If a local government or other governmental
- 6 entity required to provide public notice under this act enters into
- 7 a contract with an outside entity to host and provide public
- 8 notices, then, as used in sections 6, 7, 8, and 9, "website of the
- 9 required area" includes the website of the outside entity.
- 10 (2) If a local government or other governmental entity enters
- 11 into a contract with an outside entity to host and provide public
- 12 notices as provided under subsection (1) and that local government
- 13 or other governmental entity has a website, the local government or
- 14 other governmental entity shall provide a link on its website's
- 15 homepage to the active notice portion of the website of the outside
- 16 entity.
- 17 Sec. 12. A website used for posting public notices under this
- 18 act shall meet both of the following requirements:
- 19 (a) The homepage of the website and the portion of the website
- 20 containing active notices and archival notices shall be publicly
- 21 accessible and free.
- (b) The homepage of the website shall include a prominently
- 23 displayed link to the active notices and the archival notices.
- Sec. 13. (1) Subject to subsection (3), beginning January 1,
- 25 2015 and not later than December 31, 2024, if a local government or
- 26 other governmental entity posts a public notice on the website of
- 27 that local government or other governmental entity, the local

- 1 government or other governmental entity shall create an online
- 2 archive for public notices. In addition, the local government or
- 3 other governmental entity shall maintain in a format that includes
- 4 the dates of posting a printed copy of each public notice provided
- 5 for archival and verification purposes.
- 6 (2) Subject to subsection (3), beginning January 1, 2025, each
- 7 local government or other governmental entity shall create an
- 8 online archive for public notices. In addition, the local
- 9 government or other governmental entity shall maintain in a format
- 10 that includes the dates of posting a printed copy of each public
- 11 notice provided for archival and verification purposes.
- 12 (3) This section does not apply to a local government that
- 13 provides public notice as set forth in section 9.
- 14 Sec. 14. A notice posted on a website under this act shall be
- 15 maintained on the active notice portion of the website for the
- 16 duration the notice is required to be posted on the website under
- 17 this act. After that time, the notice shall be maintained in the
- 18 archival notice portion of the website for not less than 5 years.
- 19 Sec. 15. A person that operates a publication that qualifies
- 20 as a newspaper under this act shall maintain a permanent and
- 21 complete printed copy of each published edition for archival and
- 22 verification purposes in the required area. A person that operates
- 23 a website that qualifies as a newspaper or as a local media outlet
- 24 under this act shall create a printed copy of any notice, in a
- 25 format that includes the dates of posting, on the first day that
- 26 the notice is posted on the website and shall maintain the printed
- 27 copy in the required area for archival and verification purposes.

- 1 Sec. 16. (1) In addition to the requirements of this act, a
- 2 local government or other governmental entity may prepare an
- 3 electronic newsletter that contains the public notices required to
- 4 be provided under this act.
- 5 (2) If a local government or other governmental entity
- 6 prepares an electronic newsletter as provided under subsection (1),
- 7 the local government or other governmental entity may maintain a
- 8 permanent list of those individuals who have requested to receive
- 9 the electronic newsletter provided in subsection (1). The local
- 10 government or other governmental entity shall forward by electronic
- 11 mail to each individual on the permanent list the electronic
- 12 newsletter when it is available.

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
