HOUSE BILL No. 5768

September 9, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Hovey-Wright and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1913 PA 90, entitled

"An act authorizing and empowering the boards of supervisors of counties to purchase, acquire by condemnation, accept gifts and devises of real estate for, and to improve and maintain public parks and zoological gardens, airports and landing fields, and to contribute to the improvement and maintenance of public parks and public zoological gardens, airports and landing fields, owned or held in trust by cities, villages or townships or used for the benefit of the public; to authorize the making of reasonable rules and regulations relative to the public use of park property; and to provide penalties for violations of such rules and regulations,"

by amending section 6 (MCL 123.66).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 6. (1) Whenever—IF the COUNTY board of supervisors

COMMISSIONERS of any county shall have adopted ADOPTS a resolution
to purchase, condemn, or to—accept certain lands for park purposes,
and make an appropriation therefor under the provisions of sections

- 2 to be known and designated as "county park trustees." THE COUNTY
- 3 PARK TRUSTEES. In counties operating under the county road system,
- 4 the board of county road commissioners is hereby-designated and

- 13 PUBLIC NOTICE ACT, AND THE RULE OR REGULATION HAS BEEN POSTED IN AT
- 14 LEAST 3 CONSPICUOUS PLACES IN THE PARK PROPERTY, THE POSTERS TO BE
- 15 NOT LESS THAN 10 INCHES BY 12 INCHES IN SIZE AND PRINTED IN LEGIBLE
- 16 TYPE. THE posting OF A RULE OR REGULATION AS REQUIRED IN THIS
- 17 SUBSECTION shall be continuously maintained. IN ADDITION, BEGINNING
- 18 JANUARY 1, 2015, IF THE COUNTY HAS A WEBSITE, THE RULE OR
- 19 REGULATION SHALL REMAIN POSTED ON THAT WEBSITE INDEFINITELY AFTER
- 20 TIER C PUBLIC NOTICE HAS BEEN PROVIDED AS SET FORTH IN THE LOCAL
- 21 GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE ACT.
- 22 (4) They THE COUNTY PARK TRUSTEES shall elect a chairman
- 23 CHAIRPERSON and secretary from among their number. All expenditures
- 24 of funds so—appropriated shall be paid only by the county treasurer
- 25 on the warrant or voucher of the chairman CHAIRPERSON and 1 other
- 26 member of such THE board OF COUNTY PARK TRUSTEES. The trustee so
- 27 TRUSTEES appointed shall make a full report to the COUNTY board of

- 8 OF THIS ACT shall be immediately dissolved and cease to exist, and
- 9 the board of county road commissioners shall take the place thereof
- 10 and thereafter exercise the powers and perform the duties of the

- 12 records, and office equipment of such THE former board.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 14 unless House Bill No. 5560 of the 97th Legislature is enacted into
