A bill to amend 1965 PA 203, entitled "Commission on law enforcement standards act," (MCL 28.601 to 28.616) by adding section 9e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 9E. THE COMMISSION SHALL PROMULGATE RULES TO REQUIRE
- 2 INITIAL AND PERIODIC TRAINING REGARDING THE HANDLING OF DOGS AND
- 3 OTHER PET ANIMALS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS DURING LAW
- 4 ENFORCEMENT SITUATIONS. THE TRAINING SHALL, AT A MINIMUM, INCLUDE
- 5 INSTRUCTION IN RECOGNIZING ANIMAL BEHAVIOR TO REDUCE ENCOUNTERS
- 6 WITH DOGS AND OTHER PET ANIMALS AND APPROPRIATE NONLETHAL MEANS OF
- 7 DEALING WITH THOSE ANIMALS WHEN DESIGNATED ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICERS
- 8 ARE NOT AVAILABLE.
