January 29, 2013, Introduced by Senators GREEN, MARLEAU and PROOS and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 328 (MCL 257.328), as amended by 2004 PA 52.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 328. (1) The owner of a motor vehicle who operates or
- 2 permits the operation of the motor vehicle upon the highways of
- 3 this state or the operator of the motor vehicle shall produce,
- 4 pursuant to subsection (2), upon the request of a police officer,
- 5 evidence that the motor vehicle is insured under chapter 31 of the
- 6 insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 to 500.3179. FOR
- 7 PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, EVIDENCE THAT THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS
- 8 INSURED UNDER CHAPTER 31 OF THE INSURANCE CODE OF 1956, 1956 PA
- 9 218, MCL 500.3101 TO 500.3179, INCLUDES A COPY OF THE CERTIFICATE
 - OF INSURANCE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) THAT IS PROVIDED OR

- 1 OTHERWISE MADE AVAILABLE BY THE INSURANCE COMPANY TO THE INSURED IN
- 2 AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT AND AS DISPLAYED ON AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE.
- 3 Subject to section 907(16), an owner or operator of a motor vehicle
- 4 who fails to produce evidence of insurance under this subsection
- 5 when requested to produce that evidence or who fails to have motor
- 6 vehicle insurance for the vehicle as required under chapter 31 of
- 7 the insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 to 500.3179,
- 8 is responsible for a civil infraction.
- 9 (2) A certificate of insurance, issued by an insurance
- 10 company, that certifies that the security that meets the
- 11 requirements of sections 3101 and 3102 of the insurance code of
- 12 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 and 500.3102, is in force shall be
- 13 accepted as prima facie evidence that insurance is in force for the
- 14 motor vehicle described in the certificate of insurance until the
- 15 expiration date shown on the certificate. The certificate, in
- 16 addition to describing the motor vehicles for which insurance is in
- 17 effect, shall state the name of each person named on the policy,
- 18 policy declaration, or a declaration certificate whose operation of
- 19 the vehicle would cause the liability coverage of that insurance to
- 20 become void.
- 21 (3) If, before the appearance date on the citation, the person
- 22 submits proof to the court that the motor vehicle had insurance
- 23 meeting the requirements of sections 3101 and 3102 of the insurance
- 24 code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 and 500.3102, at the time
- 25 the violation of subsection (1) occurred, all of the following
- 26 apply:
- 27 (a) The court shall not assess a fine or costs.

- (b) The court shall not cause an abstract of the court record
 to be forwarded to the secretary of state.
- 3 (c) The court may assess a fee of not more than \$25.00, which4 shall be paid to the court funding unit.
- 5 (4) If an owner or operator of a motor vehicle is determined
- 6 to be responsible for a violation of subsection (1), the court in
- 7 which the civil infraction determination is entered may require the
- 8 person to surrender his or her operator's or chauffeur's license
- 9 unless proof that the vehicle has insurance meeting the
- 10 requirements of sections 3101 and 3102 of the insurance code of
- 11 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 and 500.3102, is submitted to the
- 12 court. If the court requires the license to be surrendered, the
- 13 court shall order the secretary of state to suspend the person's
- 14 license. The court shall immediately destroy the license and shall
- 15 forward to the secretary of state an abstract of the court record
- 16 as required by section 732. Upon receipt of the abstract, the
- 17 secretary of state shall suspend the person's license beginning
- 18 with the date on which a person is determined to be responsible for
- 19 the civil infraction for a period of 30 days or until proof of
- 20 insurance meeting the requirements of sections 3101 and 3102 of the
- 21 insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101 and 500.3102, is
- 22 submitted to the secretary of state, whichever occurs later. A
- 23 person who submits proof of insurance to the secretary of state
- 24 under this subsection shall pay a service fee of \$25.00 to the
- 25 secretary of state. The person shall not be required to be examined
- 26 as set forth in section 320c and shall not be required to pay a
- 27 replacement license fee.

- 1 (5) If an owner or operator of a motor vehicle is determined
- 2 to be responsible for a violation of subsection (1), the court in
- 3 which the civil infraction determination is entered shall notify
- 4 the secretary of state of the vehicle registration number and the
- 5 year and make of the motor vehicle being operated at the time of
- 6 the violation. This notification shall be made on the abstract or
- 7 on a form approved by the supreme court administrator. Upon
- 8 receipt, the secretary of state shall immediately enter this
- 9 information in the records of the department. The secretary of
- 10 state shall not renew, transfer, or replace the registration plate
- 11 of the vehicle involved in the violation or allow the purchase of a
- 12 new registration plate for the vehicle involved in the violation
- 13 until the owner meets the requirements of section 227a or unless
- 14 the vehicle involved in the violation is transferred or sold to a
- 15 person other than the owner's spouse, mother, father, sister,
- 16 brother, or child.
- 17 (6) An owner or operator of a motor vehicle who knowingly
- 18 produces false evidence under this section is guilty of a
- 19 misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year,
- or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 21 (7) Points shall not be entered on a driver's record pursuant
- 22 to UNDER section 320a for a violation of this section.
- 23 (8) This section does not apply to the owner or operator of a
- 24 motor vehicle that is registered in a state other than this state
- 25 or a foreign country or province.
