

# SENATE BILL No. 378

May 22, 2013, Introduced by Senators BIEDA and JONES and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 287, entitled

"An act to regulate pet shops, animal control shelters, and animal protection shelters; to establish uniform procedures and minimum requirements for adoption of dogs, cats, and ferrets; and to prescribe penalties and civil fines and to provide remedies,"

(MCL 287.331 to 287.340) by adding section 8b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 8B. (1) AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR ANIMAL PROTECTION  
2        SHELTER SHALL NOT PERMIT AN INDIVIDUAL TO ADOPT AN ANIMAL UNLESS  
3        THE ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR ANIMAL PROTECTION SHELTER HAS FIRST  
4        SEARCHED FOR THAT INDIVIDUAL ON AN ANIMAL ABUSE REGISTRY. IF AN  
5        INDIVIDUAL SEEKING TO ADOPT AN ANIMAL IS LISTED ON AN ANIMAL ABUSE  
6        REGISTRY, AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OR ANIMAL PROTECTION SHELTER  
7        SHALL NOT PERMIT THAT INDIVIDUAL TO ADOPT AN ANIMAL.

8        (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ANIMAL ABUSE REGISTRY" MEANS AN  
9        ANIMAL ABUSE REGISTRY CREATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE
