## **SENATE BILL No. 384**

May 23, 2013, Introduced by Senators MOOLENAAR and EMMONS and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 239, entitled "McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely lottery act," by amending section 32 (MCL 432.32), as amended by 2012 PA 428.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 32. (1) Before payment of a prize, of \$1,000.00 or more, the bureau shall determine both of the following:

- (a) Whether IF THE PRIZE IS \$1,000.00 OR MORE, WHETHER department of treasury records show that the lottery winner has a current liability to this state or a support arrearage.
- (b) Whether IF THE PRIZE IS \$1,000.00 OR MORE, WHETHER unemployment insurance agency records show that the lottery winner has any current liability for restitution of unemployment benefits, penalty, or interest under section 15 of the Michigan employment security act, 1936 (Ex Sess) PA 1, MCL 421.15.
  - (C) IF THE PRIZE IS \$600.00 OR MORE, WHETHER RECORDS OF THE

- 19 under subsection (3), the bureau shall apply the amount of the

- 23 an unemployment compensation debt, OR A DEBT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF

- 26 (b) Next to any support arrearage.
- (c) Next to any unemployment compensation debt.

- 1 (D) NEXT TO ANY DEBT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES UNDER
- 2 SECTION 10H OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE ACT, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.10H.
- 3 (E) (d) Next to any assigned delinquent accounts of money due
- 4 and owing to a court.
- 5 (F) (e) The balance, if any, shall be paid to the lottery
- 6 winner.
- 7 (5) Except for a payment applied to a liability under
- 8 subsection (4)(c) OR (D), a lottery winner shall be given notice
- 9 and an opportunity for a hearing before the department of treasury
- 10 or its designee with respect to the liability to which the prize is
- 11 to be applied if the liability has not been reduced to judgment or
- 12 has not been finalized under statutory review provisions of the
- 13 statute under which the liability arose. The notice shall be given
- 14 by regular mail. The lottery winner may request a hearing before
- 15 the department of treasury within 15 days after the date of the
- 16 notice by making a written request to the state treasurer.
- 17 (6) An amount applied to pay a support arrearage shall be paid
- 18 by the bureau to the department of treasury, which shall pay the
- 19 amount to the office of the friend of the court for the appropriate
- 20 judicial circuit or to the state disbursement unit in the same
- 21 manner as a payment pursuant to an order of income withholding
- 22 under section 9 of the support and parenting time enforcement act,
- 23 1982 PA 295, MCL 552.609.
- 24 (7) In regard to information provided by the department of
- 25 treasury to the bureau under this section, the bureau is subject to
- 26 the confidentiality restrictions and penalties provided in section
- 27 28(1)(f) and (2) of 1941 PA 122, MCL 205.28. In regard to

- 1 information provided by the unemployment insurance agency to the
- 2 bureau under section 15 of the Michigan employment security act,
- 3 1936 (Ex Sess) PA 1, MCL 421.15, the bureau is subject to the
- 4 confidentiality restrictions and penalties provided in sections 11
- 5 and 54 of the Michigan employment security act, 1936 (Ex Sess) PA
- 6 1, MCL 421.11 and 421.54. IN REGARD TO INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE
- 7 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO THE BUREAU, THE BUREAU IS SUBJECT
- 8 TO THE SAME EXTENT AS IS THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO
- 9 RESTRICTIONS PRESCRIBED BY FEDERAL REGULATIONS GOVERNING TEMPORARY
- 10 ASSISTANCE TO NEEDY FAMILIES OR OTHER FEDERAL PROGRAMS, BY RULES OF
- 11 THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, OR OTHERWISE, FOR PREVENTING THE
- 12 DISCLOSURE OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION TO ANY PERSON NOT AUTHORIZED
- 13 BY LAW TO RECEIVE THE INFORMATION.
- 14 (8) Each office of the friend of the court shall report to the
- 15 office of child support the names of persons who have a current
- 16 support arrearage and the office of child support shall provide
- 17 that information to the department of treasury.
- 18 (9) As used in this section:
- 19 (a) "Office of the friend of the court" means an agency
- 20 created in section 3 of the friend of the court act, 1982 PA 294,

- 22 (b) "Support" means that term as defined in section 2a of the
- 23 friend of the court act, 1982 PA 294, MCL 552.502a.
- 24 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
