- 3 GENERIC DRUGS THAT IS BASED ON WHOLESALER PRICING TO PROVIDERS AND
- 4 PHARMACISTS THAT IS AVAILABLE FROM AND PROVIDED TO WHOLESALERS WHO
- 5 DELIVER IN THIS STATE. A PROCESS FOR MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE COST PRICING
- RECONSIDERATIONS MUST BE AVAILABLE AND PROVIDED TO PROVIDERS AND
- 7 PHARMACISTS. THIS PROCESS MUST INCLUDE IDENTIFICATION OF UP TO 3
- 8 NATIONAL DRUG CODES FOR THE DRUG IN QUESTION THAT ARE ACTUALLY

- 1 AVAILABLE AND DELIVERABLE BY A MICHIGAN LICENSED WHOLESALER OR A
- 2 MICHIGAN LICENSED MANUFACTURER AND WOULD FALL INTO THE DEPARTMENT
- 3 OF COMMUNITY HEALTH OR DRUG PLANS MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE COST PRICING.
- 4 THE PROCESS MUST BE COMPLETED IN 7 DAYS. IF THE PROCESS IS NOT
- 5 COMPLETED IN 7 DAYS, THE CONTRACTED HEALTH PLAN OR THE PHARMACY
