- 14 LABORER, OR OTHER INDIVIDUAL THAT PROHIBITS OR LIMITS THE
- 15 INDIVIDUAL FROM ENGAGING IN EMPLOYMENT IS VOID.
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 17 after the date it is enacted into law.
