## **HOUSE BILL No. 4712**

June 11, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Crawford, Darany, Callton, Vaupel, Jenkins and Price and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 17820 (MCL 333.17820), as amended by 2014 PA  $_{260}$ .

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 17820. (1) An individual shall not engage in the practice of physical therapy or practice as a physical therapist assistant unless licensed or otherwise authorized under this part. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant shall engage in the treatment of a patient only upon the prescription of a health care professional who holds a license issued under part 164, 166, 170, 175, or 180, or the equivalent license issued by another state. A physical therapist or a physical therapist assistant may engage in the treatment of a patient without the prescription of a health care

- 2 175, or 180, or the equivalent license issued by another state,
- 3 under either of the following circumstances:
- 4 (a) For 21 days or 10 treatments, whichever first occurs.

- 6 condition requires physical therapy before delegating physical

- 22 "certified p.t.a.", "c.p.t.a.", "l.p.t.a.", "r.p.t.a.", and
- 23 "p.t.t.".
- 24 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 25 after the date it is enacted into law.
