## **HOUSE BILL No. 5607**

April 27, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Kosowski and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 5143.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 5143. (1) BY 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE
- 2 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 3 DEVELOP OR APPROVE AND SHALL DISSEMINATE INFORMATIONAL MATERIALS ON
- 4 CYTOMEGALOVIRUS TO EDUCATE WOMEN WHO MAY BECOME PREGNANT, EXPECTANT
- 5 PARENTS, AND PARENTS OF INFANTS ABOUT CYTOMEGALOVIRUS AND TO RAISE
- 6 AWARENESS OF CYTOMEGALOVIRUS AMONG HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS THAT
- 7 PROVIDE HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO EXPECTANT MOTHERS OR INFANTS. THE
- 8 DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING IN THE INFORMATIONAL
- 9 MATERIALS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION:

- 15 SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY SOLICIT AND ACCEPT THE ASSISTANCE OF A
- 16 MEDICAL ASSOCIATION OR COMMUNITY RESOURCE THAT THE DEPARTMENT
- 17 CONSIDERS RELEVANT, INCLUDING A FAITH-BASED RESOURCE.
- 18 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "HEALTH CARE PROVIDER" MEANS BOTH
- 19 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 20 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE
- 21 IN A HEALTH PROFESSION UNDER ARTICLE 15.
- 22 (B) A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 17.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 24 after the date it is enacted into law.
