- 5 the filing deadline, as provided in section 7 of article 4-IV of

- 7 (2) A person who has been convicted of a violation of section
- 8 12a(1) of 1941 PA 370, MCL 38.412a, shall—IS not be—eligible to—FOR
- 9 the office of state senator or representative for a period of 20
- 10 years after conviction.
