## **SENATE BILL No. 261**

April 14, 2015, Introduced by Senators HERTEL, YOUNG, MARLEAU, KNEZEK, SMITH, BIEDA, GREGORY, JONES and SHIRKEY and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 722.111 to 722.128) by adding section 3h.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 3H. (1) BEGINNING IN THE 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR, A CHILD
- 2 CARE CENTER, GROUP CHILD CARE HOME, OR FAMILY CHILD CARE HOME SHALL
- 3 REPORT ON ITS PUBLIC WEBSITE THE IMMUNIZATION COMPLETION RATE FOR
- 4 CHILDREN IN THE CARE OF THE CHILD CARE CENTER, GROUP CHILD CARE
- 5 HOME, OR FAMILY CHILD CARE HOME. THE INFORMATION SHALL BE
- 6 CATEGORIZED BY EACH VACCINE LISTED ON THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY
- HEALTH'S RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE. IF THE CHILD CARE

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- 1 CENTER, GROUP CHILD CARE HOME, OR FAMILY CHILD CARE HOME DOES NOT
- 2 MAINTAIN A PUBLIC WEBSITE, THE INFORMATION SHALL BE PROVIDED TO
- 3 PARENTS OR GUARDIANS IN ANOTHER PUBLIC MANNER.
- 4 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "IMMUNIZATION COMPLETION RATE"
- 5 MEANS THE RATE AT WHICH EACH CHILD IN THE CHILD CARE CENTER'S,
- 6 GROUP CHILD CARE HOME'S, OR FAMILY CHILD CARE HOME'S CARE HAS
- 7 RECEIVED EACH VACCINATION LISTED ON THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY
- 8 HEALTH'S RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE IN A TIMELY MANNER
- 9 ACCORDING TO THAT SCHEDULE.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
