## **SENATE BILL No. 421**

June 30, 2015, Introduced by Senators HERTEL, JONES, KNEZEK, HOOD, SCHMIDT and MARLEAU and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 653 (MCL 257.653).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 653. (1) Upon the immediate approach of an authorized
  emergency vehicle equipped with not less than 1 lighted flashing,
- 3 rotating, or oscillating lamp exhibiting a red or blue light
- 4 visible under normal atmospheric condition from a distance of 500
- feet to the front of the vehicle and when the driver is giving
- 6 audible signal by siren, exhaust whistle, or bell, ALL OF THE

## FOLLOWING APPLY:

(a) The driver of another vehicle shall yield the right of way

- 1 and shall immediately drive to a position parallel to and as close
- 2 as possible to the right-hand edge or curb of the roadway, clear of
- 3 an intersection, and shall stop and remain in that position until
- 4 the authorized emergency vehicle has passed, except when otherwise
- 5 directed by a police officer.
- 6 (b) The operator of a streetcar shall immediately stop the
- 7 car, clear of an intersection, and shall keep it in that position
- 8 until the authorized emergency vehicle has passed, except when
- 9 otherwise directed by a police officer.
- 10 (2) This section does not relieve the driver of an authorized
- 11 emergency vehicle from the duty to drive with due regard for the
- 12 safety of persons using the highway.
- 13 (3) A-EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (4) AND (5), A person
- 14 who violates this section is responsible for GUILTY OF a civil
- 15 infraction.MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 16 \$500.00 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS, OR BOTH.
- 17 (4) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION AND CAUSES INJURY TO A
- 18 POLICE OFFICER, FIREFIGHTER, OR OTHER EMERGENCY RESPONSE PERSONNEL
- 19 IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF THE APPROACHING AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY
- 20 VEHICLE IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 21 \$1,000.00 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS, OR BOTH.
- 22 (5) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION AND CAUSES DEATH TO A
- 23 POLICE OFFICER, FIREFIGHTER, OR OTHER EMERGENCY RESPONSE PERSONNEL
- 24 IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF THE APPROACHING AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY
- 25 VEHICLE IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 26 \$7,500.00 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 15 YEARS, OR BOTH.
- 27 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
