

# SENATE BILL No. 924

April 28, 2016, Introduced by Senator JONES and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
 "The code of criminal procedure,"  
 by amending section 15f of chapter XVII (MCL 777.15f), as added  
 by 2002 PA 206.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

### CHAPTER XVII

Sec. 15f. This chapter applies to the following felonies  
 enumerated in chapters 700 to 720 of the Michigan Compiled Laws:
