This section—SUBSECTION does not prohibit the regulation of noise, advertising, traffic, hours of operation, or other conditions that may accompany the use of a residence under this section.SUBSECTION.

(2) THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS THE "HOMESTEAD SUBSISTENCE FARMING ACT". IF A STRUCTURE IS LAWFULLY USED AS A RESIDENCE UNDER A ZONING ORDINANCE, THE PRODUCTION OF FARM PRODUCTS ON THE PROPERTY WHERE THE STRUCTURE IS LOCATED, FOR
