- (a) "Information submission" means information required to be submitted by a regulated person to a regulatory agency through use of the United States Postal Service.
- (b) "Regulated person" means an individual or legal entity subject to the authority of a regulatory agency.
- (c) "Regulatory agency" means a department, bureau, or agency of this state that has statutory regulatory authority over

- 2 Sec. 3. Except as otherwise provided for by law, a regulatory
