2 SEC. 5. A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL NOT ADOPT OR IMPLEMENT
3 A POLICY THAT PERMITS A PEACE OFFICER TO STOP AND SEARCH A PERSON
4 UNLESS THAT POLICY CONFORMS TO THE FOLLOWING:

- (A) THE STOP IS FOR INVESTIGATIVE PURPOSES AND THE PEACE OFFICER HAS REASONABLE SUSPICION TO BELIEVE THE PERSON HAS BEEN, IS, OR IS ABOUT TO BE ENGAGED IN CRIMINAL ACTIVITY.
- (B) THE SEARCH IS OF A PERSON STOPPED FOR INVESTIGATIVE
