A bill to amend 2016 PA 281, entitled "Medical marihuana facilities licensing act,"
(MCL 333.27101 to 333.27801) by adding section 205a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 205A. IF A COMMERCIAL ENTITY THAT SELLS, SUPPLIES, OR
- 2 PROVIDES MARIHUANA TO A REGISTERED QUALIFYING PATIENT, DIRECTLY OR
- 3 THROUGH THE PATIENT'S REGISTERED PRIMARY CAREGIVER, IS OPERATING
- 4 WITHOUT A STATE OPERATING LICENSE, AND THE COMMERCIAL ENTITY BRINGS
- 5 AN ACTION AGAINST A MUNICIPALITY BASED ON AN ORDINANCE, INCLUDING A
- 6 ZONING ORDINANCE, THAT PROHIBITS OR REGULATES THE COMMERCIAL
- 7 ENTITY, A COURT SHALL NOT GRANT EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - (A) INJUNCTIVE RELIEF AGAINST ENFORCEMENT OF THE ORDINANCE.
 - (B) DAMAGES INCURRED BECAUSE OF ENFORCEMENT OF THE ORDINANCE.
