"The code of criminal procedure,"

(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 2 to chapter IX.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER IX

2	SEC. 2. IN DETERMINING THE APPROPRIATE SENTENCE TO BE IMPOSED
3	ON A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A CRIME, THE COURT SHALL
4	CONSIDER AS A MITIGATING CIRCUMSTANCE THE FACT THAT THE DEFENDANT
5	SUFFERS FROM POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER, SUBSTANCE ABUSE, OR
6	PSYCHIATRIC OR PSYCHOLOGICAL PROBLEMS RESULTING FROM SERVICE AS A
7	MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES IN A COMBAT THEATER OF
8	OPERATIONS DURING A TIME OF WAR OR EMERGENCY.
9	Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
