HOUSE BILL No. 4827

July 12, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Chang and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to require the submitting of certain reports by certain law enforcement agencies to the Michigan commission on law enforcement standards; and to prescribe certain duties of law enforcement agencies.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "use
 of force by law enforcement reporting act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Commission" means the Michigan commission on law enforcement standards created in section 3 of the Michigan commission on law enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.603.
 - (b) "Law enforcement agency" means that term as defined in section 2 of the Michigan commission on law enforcement standards

- 4 Sec. 3. (1) Each law enforcement agency in this state, once

- 8 (2) The report must include all of the following information

- 13 control continuum for the year preceding the year of the report:
- 14 (a) The number and type of use of force complaints made

- 19 complaints against, and shooting incidents involving, officers of
- 20 the agency submitting the report.
- 21 (d) The racial, ethnic, and gender demographic data of
- 22 individuals who made use of force complaints against officers of

- 24 (e) The racial, ethnic, and gender demographic data of
- 25 individuals who were involved in shooting incidents involving
- 26 officers of the agency submitting the report.
- 27 (3) If a law enforcement agency maintains a public website,
