THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 811f. (1) The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS
- 2 SUBSECTION, THE secretary of state may, upon application, issue 1
- 3 fund-raising plate instead of a standard registration plate to a
