THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. In recognition of March 29, 1973, as the day the last
2 American troops left South Vietnam, ending nearly a decade of
3 American military intervention in that country, and in recognition
4 of the contributions and sacrifices of the American troops who
5 served in Vietnam, the legislature declares that March 29 of each
6 year shall be known as "Recognize Vietnam Veterans Day".
