## **HOUSE BILL No. 5191**

October 31, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Lucido and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 81f.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 81F. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, A
- 2 PERSON WHO ASSAULTS OR ASSAULTS AND BATTERS A VULNERABLE ADULT AND
- 3 WHO KNOWS THE INDIVIDUAL IS A VULNERABLE ADULT IS GUILTY OF A
- 4 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR
  - A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 6 (2) A PERSON WHO COMMITS AN ASSAULT OR AN ASSAULT AND BATTERY
- 7 IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1) AND WHO HAS 1 OR MORE PREVIOUS
- 8 CONVICTIONS FOR VIOLATING SUBSECTION (1) OR AN ORDINANCE OF A
- 9 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE OR OF ANOTHER STATE
- 10 SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING TO SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A FELONY

- 14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
