HOUSE BILL No. 5875

April 25, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Kosowski and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to require the department of military and veterans affairs to develop and distribute certain materials regarding apprenticeship opportunities; to provide certain training regarding apprentice programs and other benefits; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. As used in this act:

- (a) "County veterans' service officer" means a veterans' service officer accredited by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs who is employed by a county department of veterans' affairs.
- (b) "Department" means the department of military and veterans affairs.

- 4 Sec. 2. (1) The department shall, in consultation with the
- 5 workforce development agency of the department of talent and

- 7 electronic form regarding opportunities to work as an apprentice in

- 10 (2) The department shall make the material described in

- 14 (a) County veterans' service officers.
- 15 (b) The department of talent and economic development.
- 16 (c) The Michigan National Guard.
- 17 (d) Veterans' service organizations identified by the

- 19 (3) The department shall provide annual training to county
- 20 veterans' service officers and veterans' service organizations
- 21 regarding apprenticeship programs and federal and state veterans'
- 22 education benefits.
- Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 24 date it is enacted into law.
