A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1162.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1162. (1) BEGINNING IN THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR, THE
- 2 BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 3 ACADEMY SHALL EMPLOY A CERTIFIED LIBRARY MEDIA SPECIALIST FOR EACH
- 4 SCHOOL LIBRARY OPERATED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL
 - ACADEMY AS FOLLOWS:
- 6 (A) FOR A SCHOOL WITH FEWER THAN 300 PUPILS, AT LEAST 1 HALF-
- 7 TIME CERTIFIED LIBRARY MEDIA SPECIALIST.
- 8 (B) FOR A SCHOOL WITH 300 TO 1,499 PUPILS, AT LEAST 1 FULL-
- 9 TIME CERTIFIED LIBRARY MEDIA SPECIALIST.
 - (C) FOR A SCHOOL WITH 1,500 OR MORE PUPILS, AT LEAST 2 FULL-

- 2 (2) THE CERTIFIED LIBRARY MEDIA SPECIALIST SHALL WORK
