HOUSE BILL No. 6173

by amending section 3801 (MCL 600.3801), as amended by 2014 PA 387.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3801. (1) A building, vehicle, boat, aircraft, or place is a nuisance if 1 or more of the following apply:
 - (a) It is used for the purpose of lewdness, assignation, prostitution, COMMERCIAL SEX ACTS, or gambling.
 - (b) It is used by, or kept for the use of, prostitutes PERSONS ENGAGED IN COMMERCIAL SEX ACTS or other disorderly persons.
 - (c) It is used for the unlawful manufacture, transporting, sale, keeping for sale, bartering, or furnishing of a controlled substance.
 - (d) It is used for the unlawful manufacture, transporting, sale, keeping for sale, bartering, or furnishing of vinous, malt,

- 1 brewed, fermented, spirituous, or intoxicating liquors or mixed
- 2 liquors or beverages, any part of which is intoxicating.
- 3 (e) It is used for conduct prohibited by section 49 of the

- 5 (f) It is used for conduct prohibited by chapter LXVIIA of the

- 9 (2) All furniture, fixtures, and contents of a building,

- 13 (3) All controlled substances and nuisances shall MUST be
- 14 enjoined and abated as provided in this act and the court rules.
- 15 (4) A person, or a servant, agent, or employee of the person,
- 16 who owns, leases, conducts, or maintains a building, vehicle, or
- 17 place described in subsection (1) is guilty of a nuisance.
